### State Wheat Commission Boss Called to Confab

PENDLETON — E. J. Bell, administrator of the Oregon Wheat Commission, has been called to Washington, D. C., to assist in drafting legislation which would change the existing law dealing with acreage allotments and marketing quotas for wheat.

Requesting his services was Congressman Clifford R. Hope, chairman of the house committee on agriculture, who has introduced a bill calling for five changes in existing legislation. Bell was scheduled to arrive in Washington today for a 10-day stay.

Hope's proposal carries a number of features considered by growers to be more realistic than present legislation.

Of the proposed changes, one would limit reduction of acreage this year to 15 per cent (not less than 66,000,000 acres in 1954) compared to a cut of 25 to 30 per cent under the present law; another change would restore the penalty under marketing quotas to 50 per cent of parity in place of 115 cents per bushel as now provided in the law.

A third change provides that farms growing 25 acres or less would not be subject to marketing

quotas and would not be eligible to vote in the referendum. Present law provides a limit of 15 acres.

## Corrosive Sublimate Not Sufficient Protection For Possible Eel Worm Disease

There have been many rumors this spring among potato growers that it is possible to kill eel-worms in potato tubers by dipping them in corrosive sublimate. These rumors are not based on fact and no one should take a chance on infesting their soil by planting seed said to have eel-worm whether it has been dipped or has not been dipped.

Dr. John W. Oswald, Plant Pathologist, University of California, Davis, in a recent communication states that the University of California has never recommended corrosive sublimate for control of nematode, since it has never been found to be effective. Charlie Henderson, County Agent, Klamath Falls, also states that their office has never recommended the use of corrosive sublimate or any other known material to be used as a dipping in the control of nematode in seed potatoes.

Once a soil becomes infested with nematode that field has automatically lost its value for growing certified seed. Once nematode has been discovered in a field there is no known way to kill out the nematode 100 per cent. Although there are many chemicals on the market which will reduce the nematode population in infested areas, none of these chemicals are one hundred per cent effective,

so only commercial potatoes can be grown on fields thus treated. It should be remembered that under the California and Oregon certification laws, as well as most other states, that absolutely no tolerance is permitted with nematode. One potato found with nematode infested in any field grown for certification in California and Oregon, will automatically cause the entire field to be rejected for certification purposes.

For many years it was a com-

mon impression in the Klamath Basin that nematode only lived on sandy soil and was not to be found on the black, peat soils. This is untrue, since several fields are now known on the black soils to have nematode. Besides seed piece, it is possible that fields may become

infested with nematode by the livestock. Although finding nematode on your particular field may not force you out of the potato seed business it is certainly taking that farm out of production and unless extreme caution is taken it may only be a matter of time before this area, like many other areas, will be forced out of the potato seed business or the growing of certified seed greatly reduced.
