MACK LILLARD


... then ... now

Professional practitioners of the many art of self defense conceded things were looking up for pugilism the other day when Rocky Marciano, world's heavyweight champion, had lunch with President Eisenhower.

However, in the days when Mack Lillard, now the Tex Rickard of Southern Oregon, was a hard-hitting bantamweight, no invitations for box fighters to visit the White House were floating around. Nevertheless, Lillard has something in common with one President of the United States. Harry S. Truman and Lillard were both born in Lamar, Mo.

Lillard also had the distinction in 1922 of being the youngest YMCA secretary in the United States. At that time he was living in Spokane, Wash. It was there he found out that his punch packed dynamite and he reached the decision to turn professional fighter.

From 1922 to 1926 when he hung up his gloves, Lillard had 26 fights and scored 21 knockouts. He quit the ring at the height of his career after getting a draw with Danny Edwards, Negro bantamweight champion of the world.

Lillard has very definite views as to why more fighters are playing golf these days in their leisure hours than shooting craps. He gives Gene Tunney credit for elevating the profession.

"The turning point came when it was revealed that Tunney was reading Shakespeare," Lillard declared. "A lot of the boys began to take culture seriously. One fighter who adopted the Shakespeare routine used to get his opponent at close quarters and whisper in his ear, 'I come to bury Caesar, not to praise him.' Then he would bury his fist in his adversary's solar plexus."

Ann Sheridan To Mexico From 'Tense' Hollywood

HOLLYWOOD (AP)—Ann Sheridan said today she is leaving a "tense" Hollywood to make her residence in Mexico.

"I had heard that the one-time 'Omph Girl' was giving up her San Fernando Valley home to live in the land of manana. She was reported to have commented: 'Why stay in Hollywood and wait for an ulcer?' So I queried her on the 'Rage of the Jungle' set and she confirmed the report.

"Yes, I plan to sell my home in the valley and live in Mexico City," she said. "I'll probably be there six months out of the year returning to Hollywood for a couple of pictures a year. That's been my usual schedule."

She said there were several reasons for her switch. One of them is the state of the industry. "It used to be a lot of fun-making pictures," she remarked. "But nowadays everybody is so tense. There's a completely different feeling in the studios. And it's not caused by 3-D or anything like that."

I mentioned that it might be because so many film workers are out of jobs and those who are employed don't know how long it will last.

"That's probably it," she commented. "But it's not because of the 18-month tax deal. The production abroad isn't just to help actors make more money; most of the actors who go over there stay only for one picture. The studios have to make picture abroad to unfreeze their money."

Ann added that she fell in love with Mexico long ago and has wanted to live in the easier pace below the border. She also plans to make some pictures with her own company in Mexico.

Ann is selling her big valley home and will buy a smaller place. When she bought it, she said, it was out in the wilds. Like the rest of Southern California, the area has boomed and there are houses all around her. She now has to fight an hour of traffic to get to work.
