

Solon Wants Pull-Out If No Korean Truce Is Signed

WASHINGTON (AP)—Rep. Brooks (D-La.) said today that unless a truce is reached soon in Korea "we might have to pull out."

Brooks, a member of the armed services committee, said the release of thousands of prisoners of

war in South Korea increased the danger of guerrilla action against U. S. forces.

As it is, he said, there have been some U. S. casualties from guerrillas operating behind the lines.

While many of the released prisoners are friendly to the South Koreans, he said, "Some of them undoubtedly are Communist sympathizers. It looks like a bad situation."
