the province of the Supreme Court. Bloch gave reporters then a copy of a letter to Eisenhower in which he asked for an opportunity to argue the matter at the White House.

MANY DISAGREE "Tens of millions throughout the world condemn the death sentences. Our alliances are put in jeopardy because of the result of this case."

There was no immediate word as to their reaction. Friday's court decision rejected the argument of Douglas that there is substantial reason to question whether the Rosenbergs were tried under the right law.

They were convicted and sentenced under the Espionage Act of 1917, but Douglas said the court ought to pass on the question of whether they should have been sentenced under the 1946 Atomic Energy Act.
