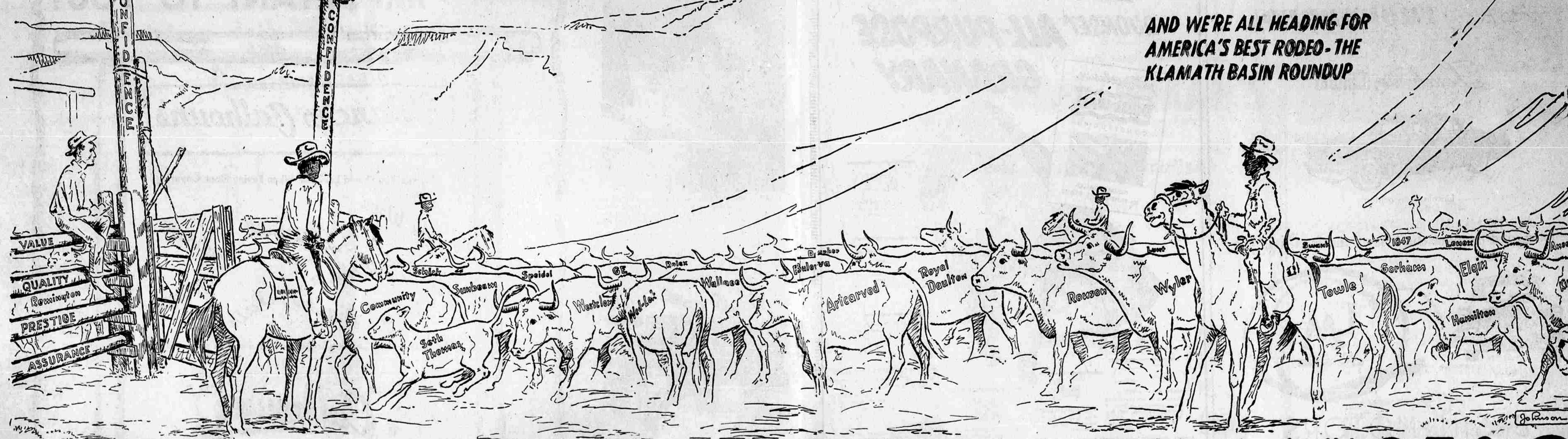
He was mated to a full blooded wolf last year. She produced two pups with "Tiger" as the sire.
