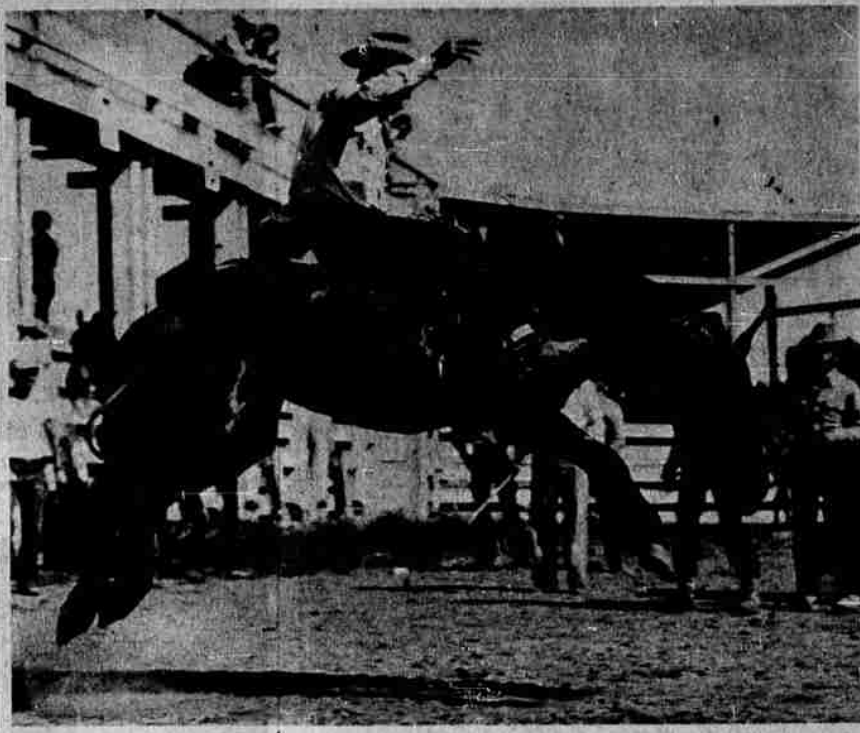

EUROPE'S TALLEST BUILDING

MILAN (AP)—Workers, idle for a month, have rushed back to the job of completing Milan's skyscraper—whose 114 meters and 29 stories will, it is believed, make it the tallest building in Europe and second highest steel-reinforced concrete building in the world. The delay was due to tradition

rather than law. The tallest spire of Milan's historic Duomo—the city cathedral—reaches 108.5 meters. Custom has had it that no building in the city may surpass the cathedral.

It took a special resolution of city council to approve continuing Milan's newest skyscraper business building beyond that height.

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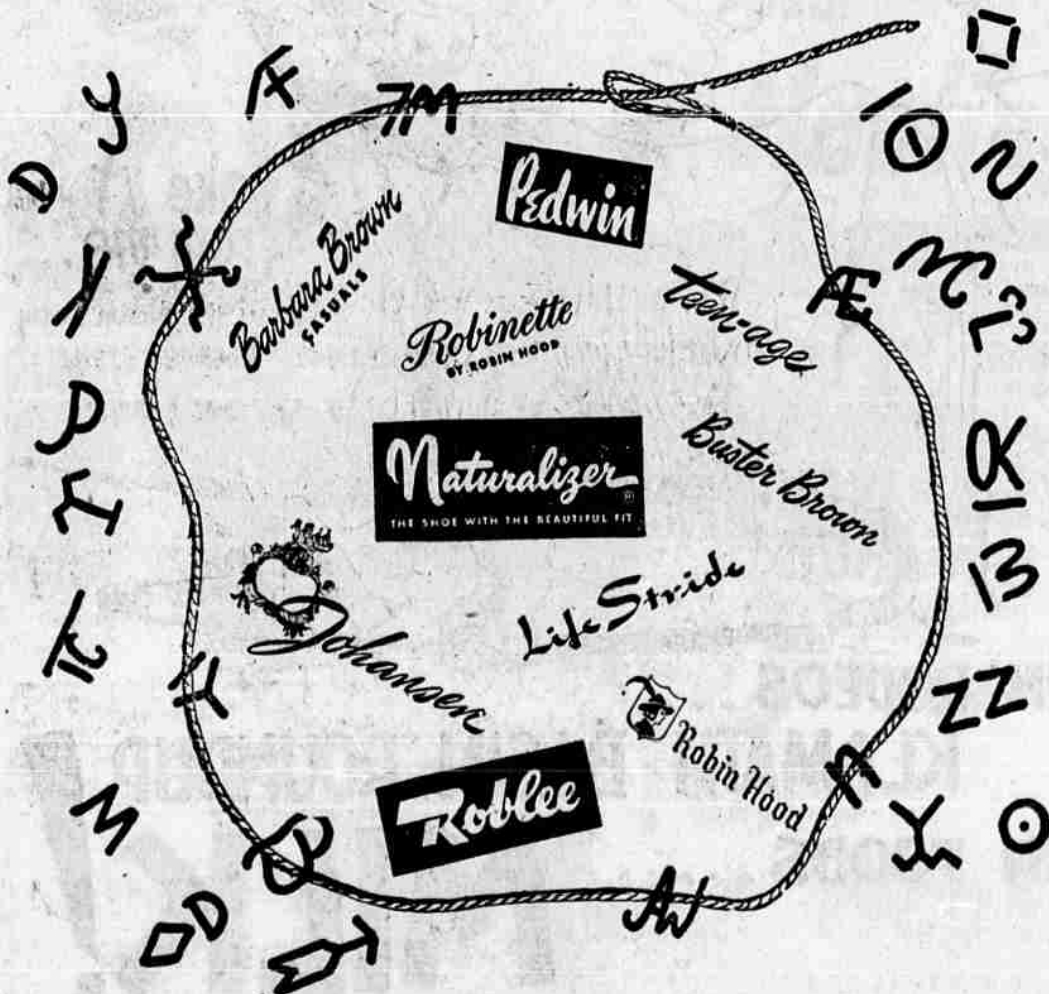
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
