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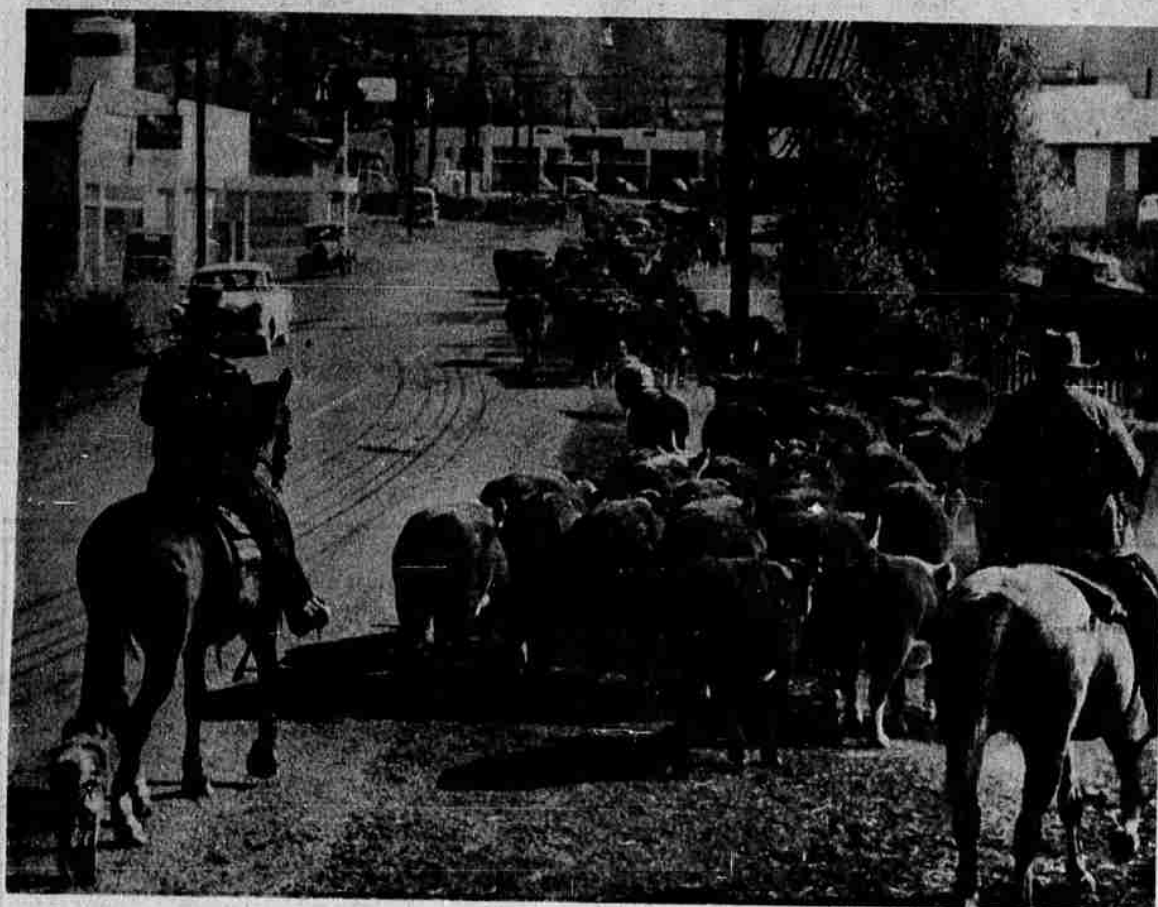

ANCIENT PAY PHONE

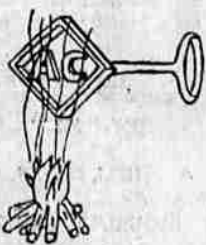
DALLAS, Tex. (AP)—What would you say if you found a telephone in a leading hotel that had bright nickel-plated slots for nickels, dimes, quarters, half dollars and silver dollars? Here's what S. Bert Hardin, 74, said: "That's a 1912 model magneto-powered coin telephone—the first coin phone ever built."

Hardin went to work for the telephone company here March 20, 1900 when Dallas had 2,359 telephones. Today there are 270,154 within the

city limits. Hardin and other old timers met recently in the 30th annual convention of the Telephone Pioneers of America's Lone Star chapter. The first coin phone was on exhibit. "Cost about five times as much to call in those days," Hardin said.
