DONNA ANDERSON has a lot of horse in Bartender but the two are good friends and don't have many arguments.

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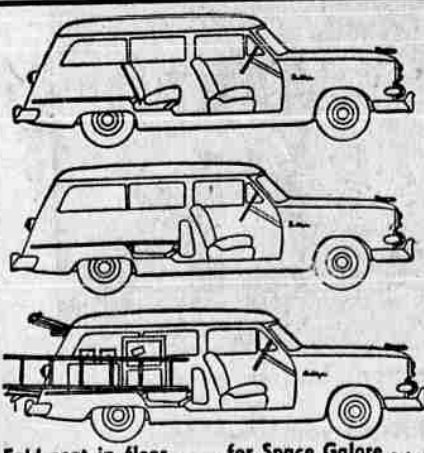
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
