Non-Professional Surveyor Upheld

SALEM (P) — The Legislature's requirements that county surveyors must be professional engineers or professional land surveyors are not valid, the Oregon Supreme Court ruled Wednesday.

The court said that since there's nothing in the Constitution listing qualifications for surveyors, the Legislature has no right to establish qualifications.

The decision means that Peter W. Welch, who was elected Multnomah County surveyor last November, is eligible to hold his office, even though he doesn't have the professional qualifications established by the 1949 Legislature.

The suit was brought by Claude G. Powers, who was elected in 1948 as surveyor. Powers tried to keep the office on the ground Welch wasn't qualified.

Other court action: Ruled that the city trash dump at Falls City, Polk County, is a public nuisance, and ordered the city to clean it up.

Permanently disbarred William E. Koken, Portland, from law practice on the ground he wrote worthless checks. Koken was admitted to practice in Oregon two years ago from the District of Columbia.

State Pro-Hells Canyon Group Lists Officers

PORTLAND (AP) — The newly formed National Hells Canyon Association, aimed at getting a federal high dam at Hells Canyon on the Snake River, is headed by James W. Marr of the Oregon State Federation of Labor.

He was elected here Tuesday when labor, farm and power groups met to draft plans for their continuing attack against the Idaho Power Company's proposals for

Snake River dam. At the organization meeting here, a resolution urged public power groups to pool their resources in regional development.

Officers elected include Vincent Cleveland, Vancouver, Wash., manager of the Clark County PUD, vice president; Elmer McClure, Portland, Oregon Grange Master, secretary-treasurer; and Albert

Ullman, Baker, and Owen Hurd, members of the executive committee.
