Two-Thirds Of The Nation Is Hot; No Relief Seen

By The Associated Press. Another day of blistering hot weather was indicated for most of the nation today. No immediate relief was in sight. Hot, moist air from the Gulf of Mexico spread across most of the eastern two-thirds of the nation and millions sweltered in the hottest and most humid weather of the summer season. Skies generally were clear. Temperatures headed for the 90s and higher over wide areas of the scorched belt after a night of unseasonable readings. Record highs for the date were set yesterday in many areas. Rain brought at least temporary relief in some areas. Rain and wind storms in Michigan and Wisconsin last night resulted in the deaths of seven persons. In Plentywood, Mont., a near cloudburst caused an estimated \$300,000 damage to crops and property. Two persons were drowned and 400 others were forced from their homes as the cloudburst raised the tiny Elder Creek 20 feet in 20 minutes. It was 85 degrees as far north as Minneapolis yesterday. Chicago's 89 was a record for the date and the fifth daily heat record in June. A top of 89 was predicted for 115 at Gila Bend, Ariz., and 113 at Blythe, Calif. More rain fell in Texas and sections of Oklahoma yesterday, bringing some relief from the hot weather and a lift to the dying crops. However, the showers were not heavy enough in the West Texas

drought area and no heavy rain-falls were forecast today. Thunderstorms, with strong gusty winds, struck areas from Upper Michigan southeastward through Michigan to Ohio last night. Two persons were killed and an un-

terminated number injured. Five persons died in a wind, hail and rain storm that swept through the Vilas County resort area of Northern Wisconsin. Four members of one family drowned when their boat capsized.
