

Nixon To Be Farm Speaker

since the first observance in 1944. Vice-President Nixon is expected to re-emphasize the purpose of National Farm Safety Week by stressing the humanitarian nature of the war on accidents to people who farm. He will dedicate his remarks to the relatives of the 14,000 farm residents killed in accidents in 1952.

Mr. Coke and Mr. Dearborn will join in asking all farm and safety leaders to take an active part in the 10th observance of the week. Mr. Dearborn is expected to make a special appeal to ministers to discuss the commandment, "Thou Shalt Not Kill," as the humanitarian theme of the first day of National Farm Safety Week.

The theme of the week, taken from the presidential proclamation, is "Live Farm to Live—So Live To Farm."

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
