

Study Committee Sees Reds Intensifying US Freeze-Out

WASHINGTON (AP) — A presidential study committee predicted Wednesday the Kremlin will intensify its efforts to isolate the United States.

The committee recommended "a greater effort to inform our citizens of the dangers that confront them."

To carry out its recommendations, the committee called for creation of a new operations coordinating board within the National Security Council.

Minister Hits Youth Center

WAXAHACHIE, Tex. (AP) — A Baptist minister assailed this town's growing youth center because he claims it is financed by gambling and tolerates mixed swimming and dancing.

Leaders of the Optimist Club, which sponsors the youth center, contend that the establishment serves a worthwhile purpose as a place of recreation for teenagers.

The Rev. Herman Rice, pastor of the Ferris Avenue Baptist Church, said yesterday his congregation strictly opposes an annual street carnival at which funds are raised for the youth center.

Rice also complained that girls and boys use the youth center swimming pool at the same time.

'Kisser-of-Death' Girl Sentenced

OAKLAND, Calif. (AP) — A 32-year-old German war bride has been sentenced to from five years to life for the "kiss of death" murder of her husband.

William Pelton was found shot to death in his car on a lonely road near Niles, Calif., Feb. 1. On his forehead was the lipstick imprint of a woman's kiss.

Mrs. Hildegard Garmel Pelton was nabbed by the FBI in New York city a month later after a widespread search. She confessed she shot her husband because he was cruel to her and then kissed him because she still loved him.

She was found guilty of second degree murder and will become eligible for parole in 2½ years.

PARIS (AP) — Rosemonde Gerard, 83, widow of the French poet Edmond Rostand, died today at her home in Paris.

Her husband, author of "Cyrano de Bergerac," died in 1918.

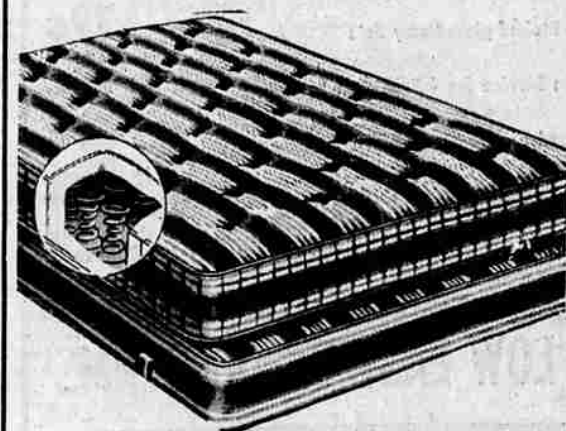
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TOP COMMUNITY FLOAT in the Fourth of July Roundup parade according to the judges was this Fort Klamath entry.

Out-Of-Doors Circus Slated
