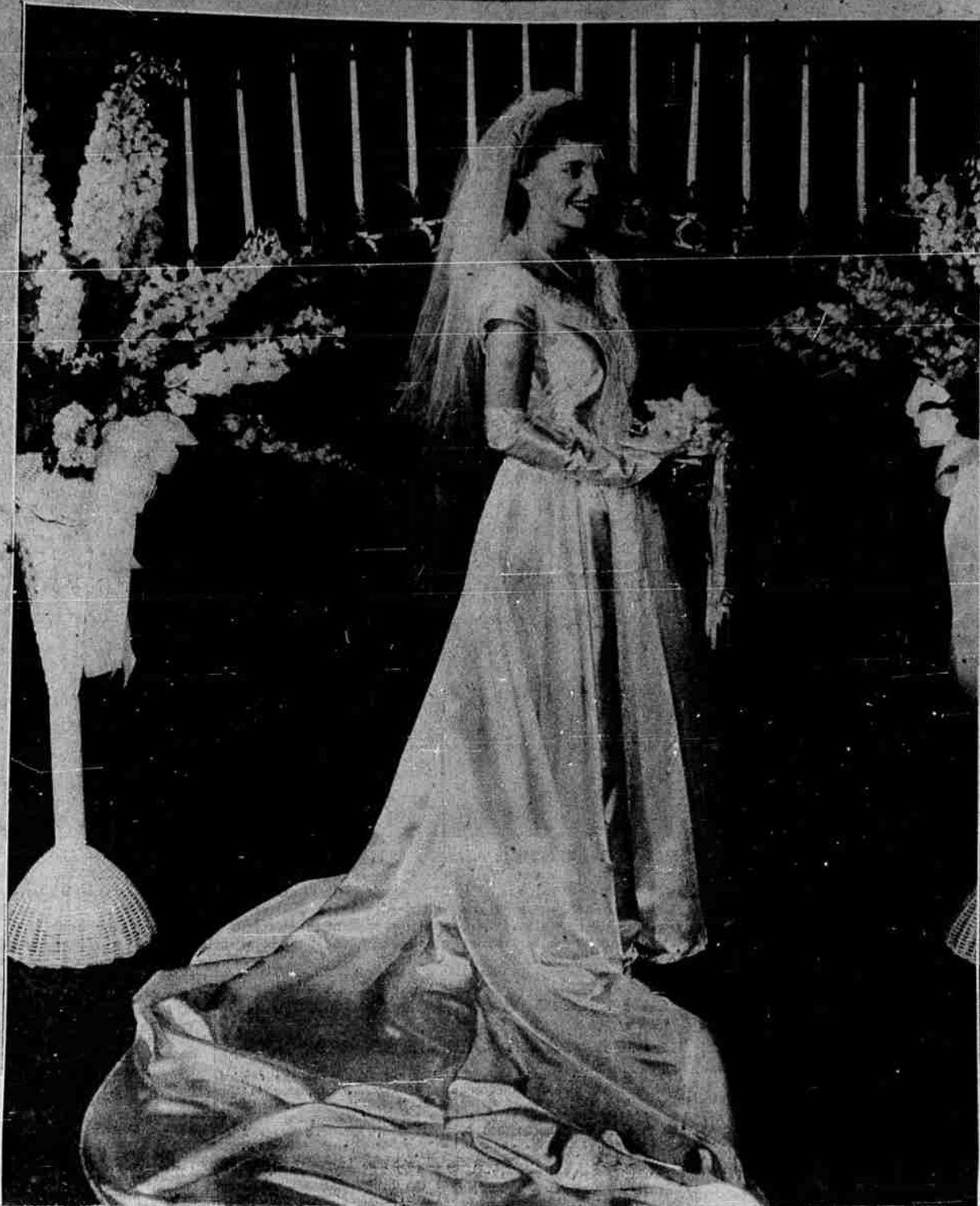


Beverly Karnes' Wedding Is Social Event of Summer
