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THE ONLY POWDERED PECTIN
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HOMEMADE JAMS AND JELLIES
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Withdrawal Of Two Armies Is Smooth; Deadline Thursday

SEOUL (AP)—The withdrawal of two mighty armies from the Korean demilitarized zone continued smoothly today as the Thursday night deadline approached.

Enemies a few days ago, Allied and Communist troops worked within shouting distance of each other, salvaging material and wrecking fortifications that took months, sometimes years, to build.

Although Allied troops were warned by the 8th Army against fraternization with the Reds, there were reports of friendly contacts all along the war-shattered front.

The Reds accused the Allies of eight violations of the demilitarized zone at Wednesday's session of the Korean Armistice Commission.

They charged three United Nations planes flew over the buffer zone and that one machine gun burst and four artillery rounds were fired after the cease-fire became effective.

Maj. Gen. Blackshear M. Bryan, chief Allied delegate to the commission, called the charges "allegations, broad and general, and nothing serious."

"None have been substantiated," Bryan declared.

Under terms of the armistice signed Monday, both sides are to have pulled back 1 1/2 miles each from the truce line by 10 p. m. Thursday (8 a. m. EST)—three days after the cease-fire.

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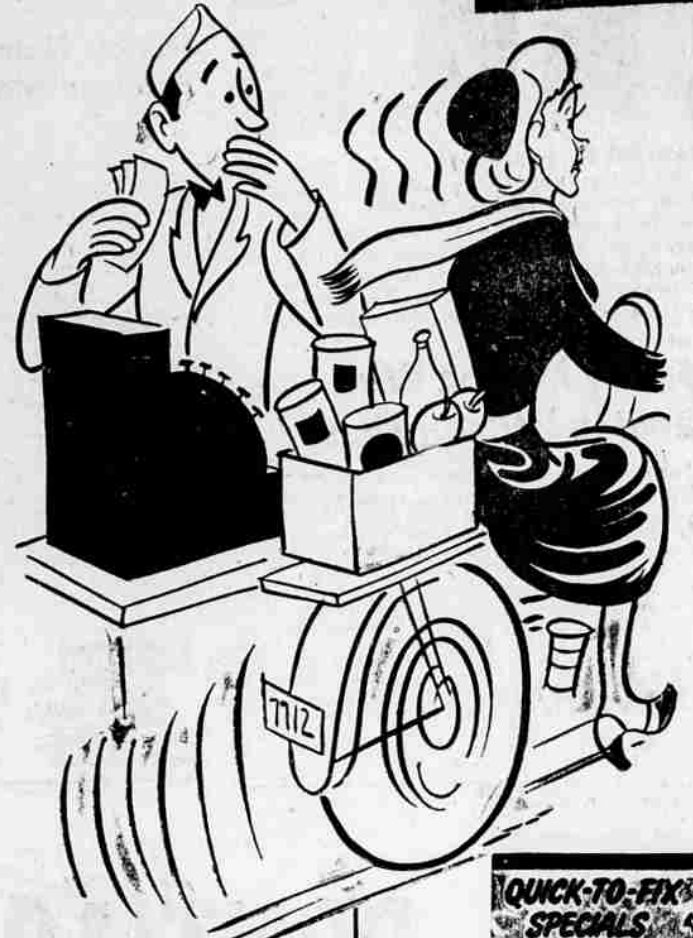
