



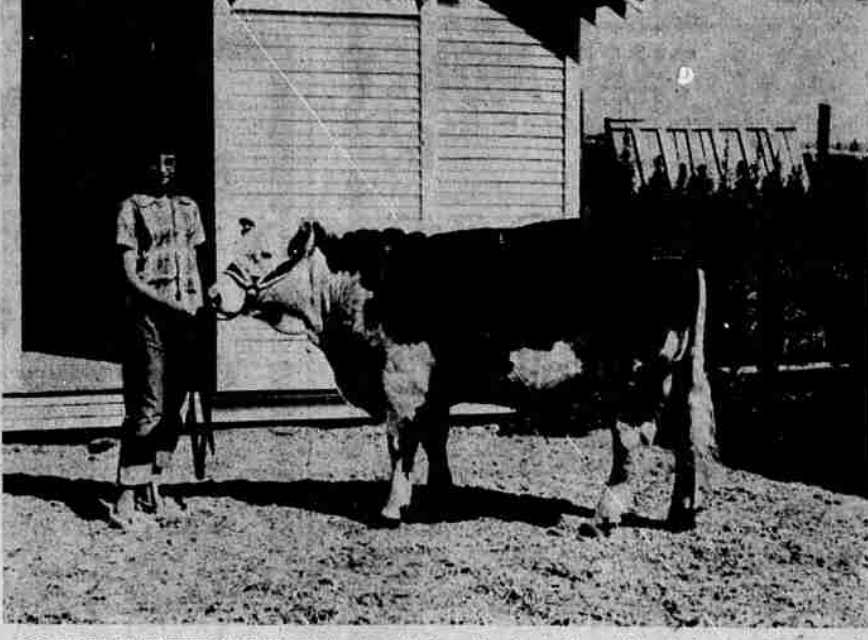

The 4-H club junior livestock projects are well toward the finishing off stages in preparation for the 18th annual Junior Livestock Show, it was determined in a series of tours throughout the country last Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday.

The show is scheduled for Aug. 23-24-25 at the Klamath County Fairgrounds, Rotarians, sponsors of the event, under the direction of Francis Skinner, 4-H club agent, visited 160 4-H homes looking over the animals.

On Tuesday two groups covered Langell Valley, and from Keno north to Wood River Valley. The Henley and Merrill districts were visited Wednesday. Thursday tours took in Malin, Poe Valley and Klamath Falls suburban districts.

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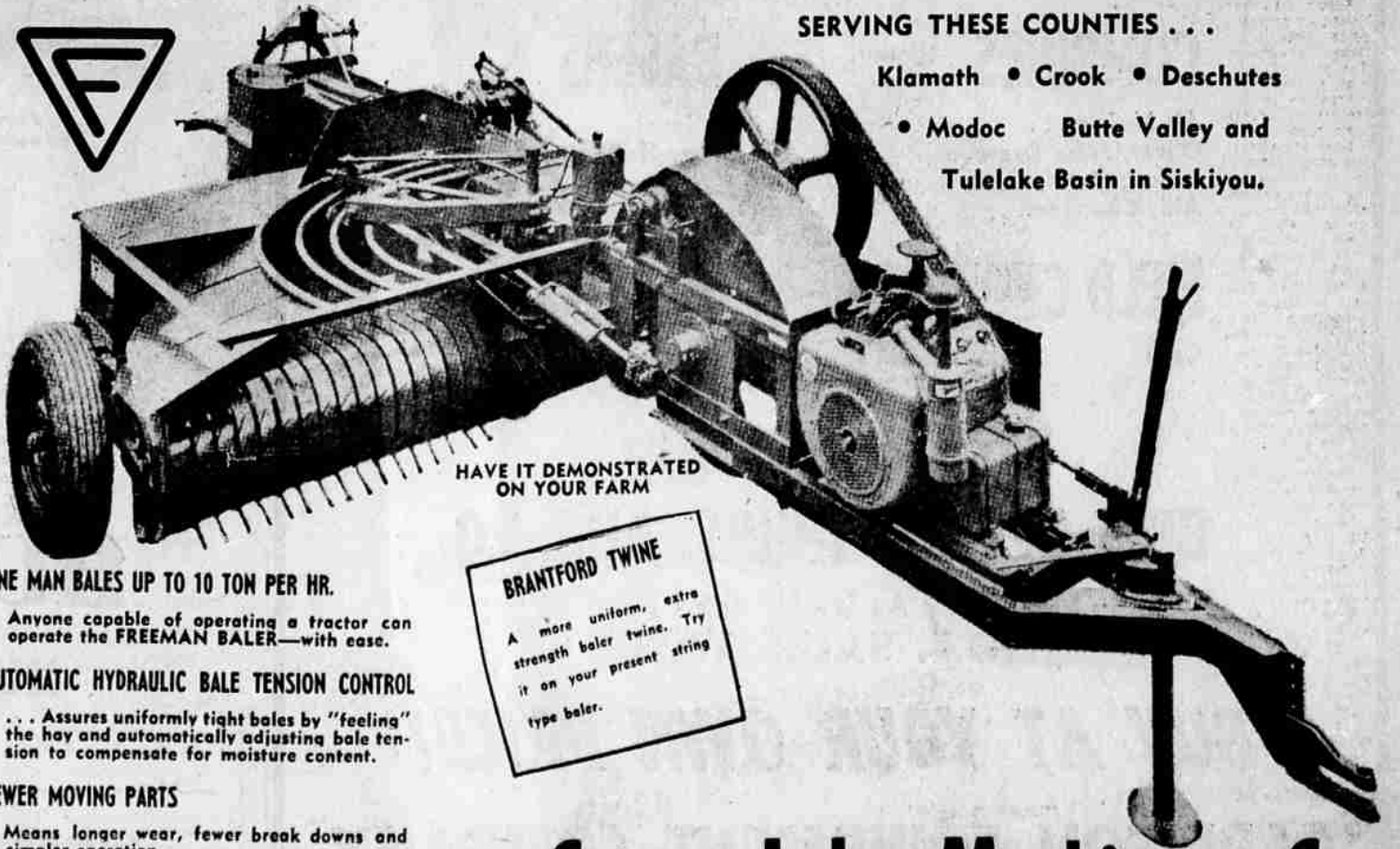
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
