N. Idaho Amid 'Worst' Fire

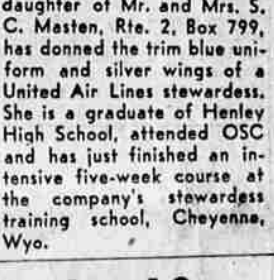
