Pendleton Named Locale Of Catholics' CCD Meet

Eastern Oregon has been selected for the Seventh Regional Congress of the Confederation of Christian Doctrine to be held September 19 to 21.

Members of the Catholic Hierarchy, Priests, teaching and supervising Nuns and lay people will assemble at Pendleton for the Regional Congress from the states of Oregon, Washington, Idaho, Montana and Alaska. Theme for the Congress this year will be, "Every Catholic—An Apostle."

Clergy from the Basin who will attend include the Very Rev. T. P. Casey, Klamath Falls; the Rev. John Phelan, Merrill; the Rev. James O'Connor and the Rev. Patrick Lunham, Lakeview; the Rev. William S. Stone.

Speakers from this area will be Mrs. Percy Murray, Klamath Falls, "The Course of Study"; Mrs. Paul Landry, "The Confession of Christian Doctrine in the Northwest"; Mr. Vincent Killen, Lakeview, "Catechetical Day in the Baker Diocese."

General Sessions will be held commencing Saturday afternoon, Sept. 19, at 2 p.m. at Vert Hall with the Most Rev. Francis P. Leipzig, D.D., Bishop of Baker presiding and the Rev. William S. Stone, CCD Director of Baker, as Chairman.

Various subjects will be discussed during the three day session, with General Sessions held Saturday afternoon and evening, Sunday morning and afternoon and Monday morning.

One of the high lights of the Regional Congress will be the Pontifical High Mass at St. Mary's Church at 9 a.m. Sunday morning, Sept. 20, with the Most Rev. Charles J. White, D.D., Spokane, presiding.
