Bus Crash Kills Three

EHRENBERG, Ariz. (AP)—A loaded passenger bus crashed, apparently into a stone embankment, on lonely U. S. Highway 60-70 last night, killing the driver and two passengers.

The crash injured all other 28 passengers aboard, the highway patrol reported. At least five were in critical condition in Palo Verde Hospital, Blythe, Calif.

Coroner Ben White of Riverside (Calif.) County identified two of the dead as:

Adolph Collins, 46, Culver City, Calif., the driver.

Orman L. Barrett, 60, Hayward, Calif.

The other passenger, a man, has not been identified.
