Comedians Are Born, Bert Lahr, Old Schooler, Says

HOLLYWOOD (AP) — Are comedians born or made? Bert Lahr, a comic of the old school, says they are born, but not the kind that is found in decrepit theaters today.

"Burlesque was clean in those days," he recalled. "There was no such thing as the strip tease. I can remember seeing signs backstage that warned actors would be fined \$10 if they used profanity on-stage. I played one house in Omaha that advertised 'we want women.' The place was packed with women at the matinee."

Although burlesque and vaudeville were good training grounds for comedians, Lahr opined that they were born that way.

"I mean the real comic — the clown," he explained. "The real comic is one who can come out and say 'Hello' and make the audience laugh at him. Bobby Clark and Ed Wynn can do it. You can't name many more."

"The trouble with most present-day comedians is that they're all alike. They stand up and tell jokes. That's all they do, and they're only as funny as the jokes that are written for them."

"Back in the old days of Broadway, each comic had his own style."

"About the only newcomer who has shown an original comic style is Jerry Lewis."

Lahr admitted the future is dark.

Gilchrist Hi Newsnotes

Harry C. Parker, Ranger National Park, came to Gilchrist to speak to the high school on the part that national parks play in forest conservation, Oct. 6.

After a brief explanation of a national park, Parker told the students the history of the parks, explained types of parks in the United States and showed how national parks differ from national forests in forest conservation because they preserve the forests and wildlife in their natural state.

National parks are organized to save nature's museums for future generations, but Parker also pointed out they are important for the people of today in human conservation, too.

Walter G. Dahms, Research Forester, led the Gilchrist Junior High School on a field trip through Fringe Falls experimental forest Sept. 20.

Dahms explained the re-search being carried on in planting trees, cutting high risk trees, ridding trees of parasites and thinning.

John J. Taylor, caretaker at Wickup Reservoir, conducted the group through the Wickup Dam.
