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Business Gets Dividend Lift

NEW YORK (AP)—The season's first batch of third quarter earnings reports gave business a psychological lift last week. The uptick in earnings was seen as a sign of recovery from the recession.

Advances were reported in such vital areas of the economy as auto production, heavy construction, contract awards, money in circulation and retail trade. Steel output, scheduled at just under 95 per cent of capacity, showed little change from the week before.

Reds Reportedly Storm Out Of Repatriation Meeting

PANMUNJOM (AP)—Seated in their demand that Indian troops force defiant Korean War prisoners to listen to Red persuasion teams, the two Communist delegations reportedly stormed out of a meeting today.

The Polish and Czech walkout threatened a collapse in the tense negotiations of 23,400 anti-Communist prisoners who refused to return to their homelands. The sources, who declined to be named, said the Swedish, Swiss and Indian members of the five nation commission sided together.

A commission spokesman said there would be no explanation Tuesday. The Reds had refused to interview Chinese instead of the North Koreans they had asked for. A 15-hour repatriation commission debate on the matter was ended by the walkout of Czechs.

RUSSIANS CATCH JAPS
TOKYO (AP)—Russian patrol boats captured two Japanese fishing boats Saturday near the Russian-held Habomai Islands. The Japanese boats were carrying a few miles east of Japan's northernmost island of Hokkaido, the newspaper Asahi reported.

One Japanese boat was reported adrift with engine trouble, and another was operating less than two miles from the Habomai when they were captured, Asahi said. A Korean repatriation commission meeting today.

and Poles, an informed source said. The North Koreans have stubbornly refused to move out of their compounds to meet with Red explanation teams. Only 19 of 221 Chinese interviewed asked for repatriation. Six North Koreans who requested repatriation were turned over to the Reds, raising to 131 the number of POWs who have returned to Red rule without first meeting with the Red explainers.

In all, some 22,400 anti-Red POWs are in custody of the repatriation commission. Communist correspondent William Burchett, who often echoes official Red policy, said one of the main disputes between the Reds and the repatriation commission was over who has the right to determine explanation plans.

Burchett said the Communists believe they have the right to determine whether they will explain to Chinese or North Korean captives and they also want to say when they will talk to the POWs.

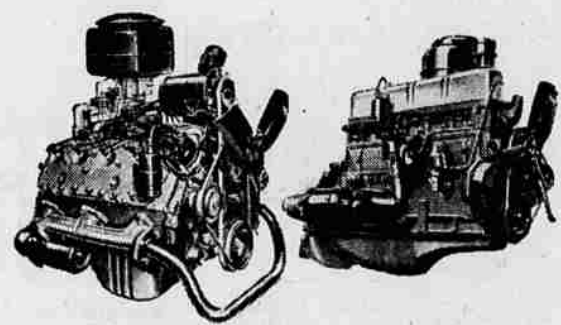
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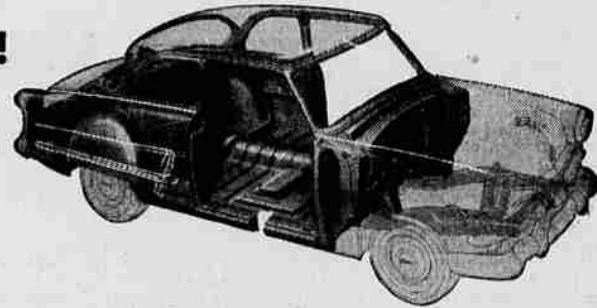
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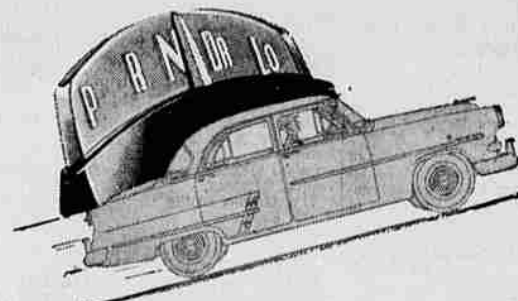
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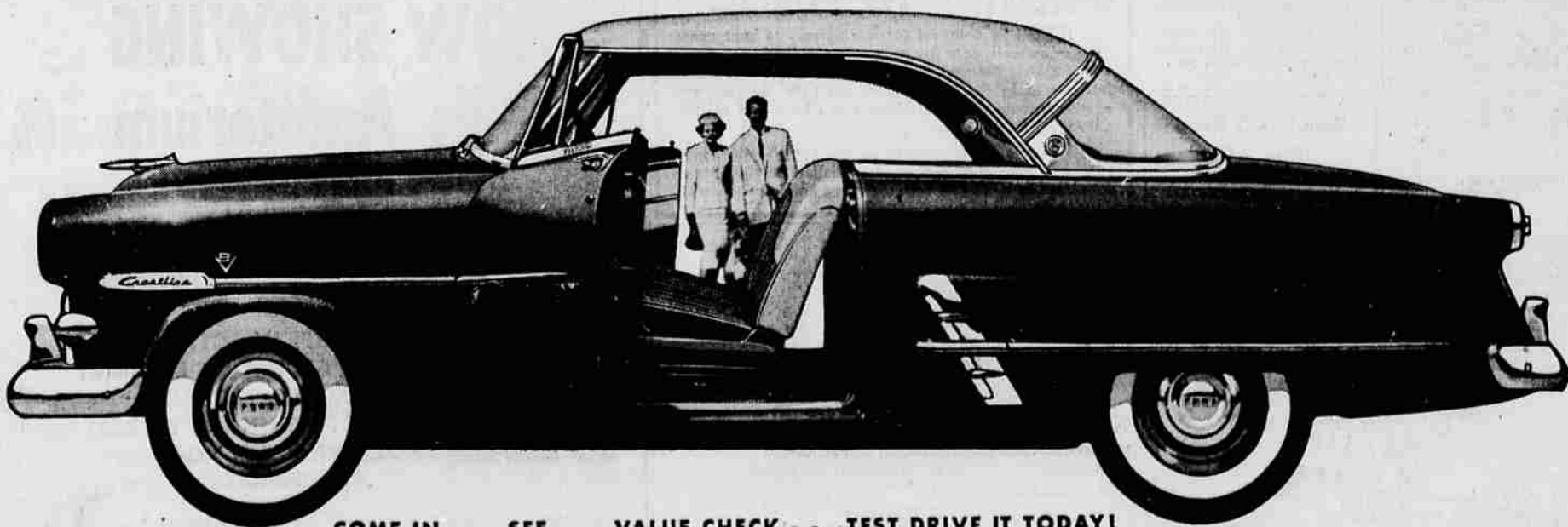
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
