CHICAGO LIVESTOCK

CHICAGO (AP) — A steady to weak market developed for live hogs Thursday on receipt of a thousand more slaughter animals than expected.

Cattle were unevenly 25 cents a hundred pounds higher to 25 lower while sheep were steady to \$1.00 higher.

A short load of barrows and gilts averaging 230 pounds sold at a top price of \$21.75 but most deals were from \$21.00 to \$21.50. Sows took \$19.00 to \$20.75.

Good and choice steers mostly sold from \$19.50 to \$20.50. Cows topped at \$13.00.

Good and choice fed woolled lambs sold at \$18.00 to \$20.00 but the top got up to \$21.00.

Salable receipts were estimated at 10,000 hogs, 3,000 cattle, 500 calves and 2,000 sheep.
