Gill Reported Out of Running—The Oregonian said Saturday it had learned State Sen. Warren Gill of Lebanon will not be named U. S. district attorney for Oregon.

The newspaper said its information was from "informed Washington sources" on Gill's turn-down because of opposition from the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People.

Atty. Gen. Herbert Brownell announced the decision during a 30-minute interview in Washington Friday with Jess Gard, Portland, Oregon Republican national committeeman, the newspaper said.

Gard could not be reached to comment on the report.

The Oregonian said the rejection of Gill "was understood to be exclusively a victory for the NAACP" which opposed Gill because he opposed civil rights legislation passed by the last state Legislature.

Gill has contended that his opposition to the legislation was on constitutional grounds only.

Gill, when notified of the Oregonian report said: "I believe the Negroes were wrong in their apprehension about me. None of them ever talked to me. I believe Mr. Brownell was wrong if he was influenced by them. However, they both have the right to be wrong."

"This particular appointment is now a closed chapter, but the wisdom of appeasement in our relations with political pressure groups as well as with nations at the sacrifice of principle remains a very pertinent and vital question in our country."

The post now is held by Henry L. Hess, a Democrat who submitted his resignation last spring.

Otto Rutherford, Portland NAACP president, said: "This was not an issue involving personalities. It is truly an issue involving principle, a principle that is supposedly backed by national and state leadership..."

Advice Fails; Boy Dies Of Dog Bite—LOUISVILLE, Ky. (AP)—Offers of help and advice from many parts of the world couldn't save the Temple Lewis III.

The 4-year-old boy died Friday the ninth day after symptoms began indicating he had been bitten by a rabid dog.

That is nearly twice as long as the average person lives after the symptoms show and doctors had been encouraged that the disease might possibly run its course.

The boy weakened Thursday, however, and death came Friday morning.

His parents had pleaded for a miracle cure from some obscure letters came from far and wide, and doctors refused to make a "miraculous" human guinea pig.
