At the request of Gilchrist residents, the Red Cross Bloodmobile from the Portland Center, has scheduled a mobile operation at Gilchrist high school, Monday, Nov. 9, from 2 to 6 p.m.

Jacob Finstad is recruiting chairman for donors. The visit is sponsored by the Lumber and Sawmill Workers Union, Gilchrist, and plans are being made for a house-to-house canvass for donors. Prospective donors in the Chemult, Crescent and Gilchrist areas are urged to contact Finstad for appointments.

This is the second visit the Bloodmobile will make to Gilchrist. 27 pints were secured on the first visit but the community set a goal of 200 donors for the return visit. Interest in the program was sparked by a feeling of responsibility on the part of the community to replace blood which had been used in large quantities in the treatment of a Gilchrist resident who suffered severe burns.

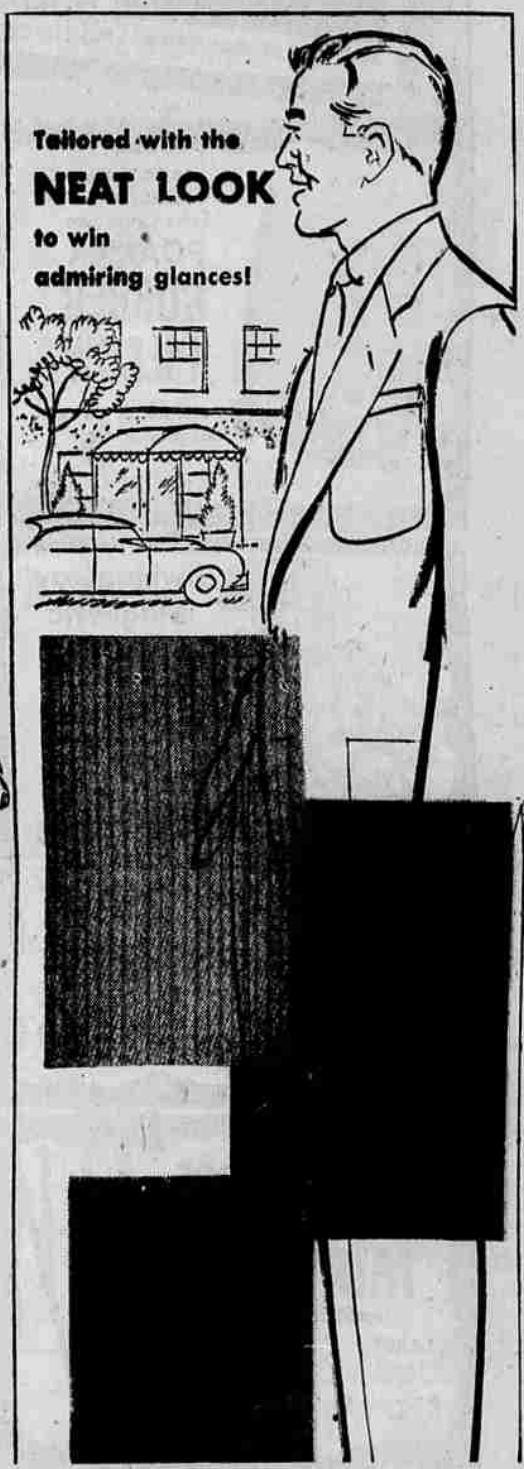
