

Butte Valleyites Want 3 School Districts Combined

MACDOEL — Unionization of the three elementary school districts now serving the south end of Butte Valley into one large district with a big new school at Macdoel is the subject of petitions circulated in the area.

The petitions making the rounds in the Red Rock, Mt. Hebron and Macdoel school districts ask W. E. Roberts, county school superintendent, to call a special election so registered voters of each district may decide the question.

Only parents of children en-

rolled in the schools may sign the petitions, but all registered voters in the districts may cast their ballots in the special election when and if it is called. For unionization to take place, a majority must vote yes in each district.

The Macdoel school now has 77 children enrolled with three teachers for eight grades. Both Mt. Hebron and Red Rock are one-room, one-teacher schools. Each school has about 20 pupils enrolled. Red Rock is about 10 miles east of Macdoel and Mt. Hebron is only about three miles south of Macdoel.

Macdoel appears already overdue for a new school building. The present frame structure, dating back to about 1900, is not only overcrowded but was inspected last week by a state fire marshal, whose official report, if the worst fears of residents are realized, may condemn the old building.

If that were to happen the Macdoel school would probably be closed and the school board forced to find other quarters for the pupils, perhaps in the Dorris school or in other Macdoel buildings, until the defects were either repaired or a new school built.

Macdoel Principal Merlyn McGinnis declared himself in favor of a merger of the three districts. "Unionization would give much more to the students, such as a broadening of educational facilities and more and better teachers."

He pointed out that a large school serving the three districts could have a hot lunch program, adequate playground equipment, organized sports and landscaped grounds, and that an all-purpose room would give civic organizations at the south end of Butte Valley a modern meeting place.

Some in the Mt. Hebron and Red Rock districts are not in favor of any change. They point out that their taxes are lower now than at Macdoel, that a change would mean their children would have to go to school on the bus and those in the lower grades who now get home early in the afternoon would have to wait for the bus to take them home.

Some are fearful that removal of the Mt. Hebron school would lower their property values, and others are perhaps fearful that a union school board may not be as responsive to their wishes as a strictly local board, although each district would have a representative on the new board.

CHICAGO LIVESTOCK

CHICAGO, Nov. 10 — Receipts of livestock Wednesday were far below advance estimates and the fewest for a Wednesday since Sept. 2. The resulting disappointment to the buying side was reflected in the higher prices they were required to pay usually in order to fill their orders.

Hogs moved at steady to 25 cents a hundred pounds higher in an active turnover. Cattle were irregularly from 50 cents higher on steers and heifers to as much as 50 lower on cows which comprised about 30 per cent of the run. Sheep were generally steady.

Most butcher weight hogs sold at \$20.35 to \$20.50. Sows brought \$17.25 to \$19.00.

Good to prime steers sold mostly from \$19.50 to \$28.50. Good and choice heifers made \$18.00 to \$24.00.

In general woolled lambs sold downward from \$19.50 and clipppers from \$18.25.

Salable receipts were estimated at 5,300 hogs, 7,000 cattle, 300 calves and 2,000 sheep.
