

Child Clinic Work Talked by Experts

John Waterman, psychiatrist and pediatric social worker, associated with the Oregon State Council of Health met with the advisory council of the Klamath County Child Guidance Clinic, Nov. 12, at the clinic here. He was accompanied by Mrs. Waterman. Local members who have been interested in the proposed organization were gratified at the professional advice given during the meeting. During his conference he took under study several children referred by the schools, local physicians, the juvenile court and the state welfare agency. The Waterman is also meeting with a group of elementary teachers and is organizing one afternoon session of the clinic. The clinic will conduct a forum orienting members and others interested in the work of the clinic. An application has been made to the state board of health for help finance the clinic for the balance of the fiscal year in anticipation of employing a full-time psychiatric social worker. The clinic may be extended to other services in the field of mental health and ways to finance the clinic locally.

WASHINGTON (AP) — Strategy for the 1954 session of Congress will be mapped at talks Dec. 10-12 between President Eisenhower, members of his cabinet and Republican congressional leaders. This was announced late Saturday by Sen. Knowland of California, the GOP senate leader. He said legislation agreed upon at the December talks "should be expected."

Knowland said the first bill to be considered by the Senate in January presumably will be one to authorize U.S. participation in the Lawrence Seaway, Canada has said it will build the seaway. He said Congress again refuses to authorize U.S. participation.

As usual several minor automobile collisions marred the weekend for the Klamath Basin, according to state police who investigated the accidents.

Saturday afternoon about 4 p.m. a car driven by Mrs. Enil Polvka, Malin, slowed down to permit a car to turn in a private driveway near the Malin-Tulelake junction on Highway 39 east of Merrill and her car was hit in the rear by a Ford Sedan driven by Joseph Elmer Mauch, Tulelake, which in turn was hit from behind by a Studebaker coupe operated by Pearl Adeline Ketchum, Malin, which was crashed into by a fourth car driven by Henry Vochwitz, Malin.

There were no injuries but the Vochwitz and Ketchum cars were towed to Klamath Falls for repairs.

About 8:30 p.m. Saturday night a car driven by William John Sellinsky, address Municipal Airport, was struck broadside at the intersection of Summers Lane and John's Ave. by a Ford Ranch wagon operated by Mrs. Anna Geneva Dodson, Dorris. The Dorris woman was arrested by state police for failure to stop at a stop sign.

A one car accident occurred about 2 a.m. Sunday when a Dodge Coach operated by Manuel Guitierrez, Banning, Calif., failed to negotiate a turn after crossing a canal bridge on Eberlein near Alameda and rolled over in the ditch. The driver and three passengers were not injured. Guitierrez was cited for having no operators license.

Portland Hotel Razed by Fire

PORTLAND (AP) — Fire, believed started in the basement, spread through the 70-room Franklin Hotel Saturday night.

There were no deaths or injuries as the guests fled out of the three-story building. Damage was estimated by the Fire Department at \$47,000.

The three-alarm blaze also destroyed several shops on the street level.

Hundreds of persons watched the fire in downtown Portland at 13th and Washington streets. Traffic in the area was halted by fire equipment called to the scene.

Potential Killer Takes Own Life

BALTIMORE (AP) — Police said Arthur E. Cobb, 28, shot and wounded his 74-year-old grandmother yesterday, then killed himself after she refused his request for cartridges so he could "shoot his cousin."

Cobb's death was listed as suicide by Dr. Russell S. Fisher, chief medical examiner.

Mrs. Charles M. Nicholson, the grandmother, was shot in the chest with a .22-caliber pistol, the bullet passing completely through her body. Her condition was not serious.

Two Hurt In Rail Crash

Another car train accident occurred around 5 a.m. Sunday morning when a '52 Cadillac driven by Arthur Kellert, 68, Kirby, Ore., crashed into a Great Northern freight car on Washburn Way near the Great Northern roundhouse.

Kellert accompanied by his son Harry, 23, 924 Alameda, were leaving town for a morning's hunt of ducks and geese when the accident occurred.

Heavy fog covered the crossing and the driver apparently did not see the train until too late to stop, according to Oregon State Police, who investigated. There are no traffic signals at the crossing.

The heavy car hit with such impact that it knocked one freight car from the track. The Cadillac was completely demolished.

The two men were taken to Klamath Valley Hospital by Klamath Ambulance Service where the elder Kellert was reported to have broken ribs, cuts and bruises and his son suffered head cuts and facial lacerations. Both men were resting easily this morning and their condition is not considered serious, according to hospital authorities.
