

Storm Puts Slick Coat On Highway

Meager reports reaching here from Yreka this morning states a number of truck and car accidents occurred near the Hebron Summit on Highway 97 south of Macdoel during the snow storm Monday night.

About 4:30 p.m. a car and house trailer belonging to a Mr. and Mrs. Russell Holme who with an unidentified couple had just finished

eating in the trailer and returned to the car to continue their journey when a truck and trailer combination loaded with cattle sideswiped and completely demolished the house trailer.

One cow was reported killed when the trailer overturned after crashing into the house trailer. The rest of the load of beef was reportedly spilled on the roadside and most of them were still at large today.

The truck and trailer was owned by the Garibaldi Trucking Co., San Francisco and operated by Lester J. Farrell of the same city.

Not seeing the pileup ahead in time to stop, a car driven by Albert W. Edsall, Macdoel plowed into the overturned trailer and was in turn rammed by a truck driven by S. E. King, Jacksonville.

A call to Dorris revealed that a Mr. and Mrs. Rodney P. Watson, address unknown, had their Chrysler car completely demolished in another crash with a truck. The Watsons were treated at the Dorris Hospital for minor injuries and released.

According to Fenton Mahrt,

Dorris chief of police, it was snowed a total of 18 cars and trucks reported to have turned over and were in the ditch during the night. A truck load of baled hay was burned after skidding on the icy pavement.

LOS ANGELES (AP)—Conciliation proceedings by which Jess Barker hopes to save his marriage to Susan Hayward have been continued until Jan. 19.

But the actress said she did not believe continuance of the marriage would be best for their 8-year-old twin sons, since she no longer loves Barker. The couple spent two hours yesterday discussing their problems with a Children's Court of Conciliation commissioner.

Miss Hayward filed her divorce suit in September, charging mental cruelty. She and Barker were married in 1944 and separated last July.

Escapee Tells of Pro-Red Threats

SEOUL (AP)—A South Korean war prisoner who escaped Monday from a compound in the neutral zone said today he narrowly avoided execution by pro-Communist POWs.

Cpl. Pak Ki Do said he was tried and sentenced to death by a 45-man Communist collaboration committee. A compound holding more than 300 South Koreans reported to have chosen communism.

He said his trial was arranged after Red leaders discovered his secret plan to return to South Korea. He left just in time.
