LONDON IR — Prime Minister Churchill's Conservatives beat down a rebellion in their own ranks last might, winning approval in the House of Lords of Cabinet plans to introduce commercial television in Britain.

The peers by a 157-87 vote defeated a motion opposing the government's scheme. A full debate is now slated for the House of Commons.

The nation's present TV and radio are a monopoly of the publicly owned British Broadcasting Corp. Under the new plan, some advertising would be accepted to earn money for improving and expanding the service.

Farm Sales Figure Up

WASHINGTON 18.—The Agricul-ture Department says farm sales were slightly bigger during the first 10 months of 1953 than in the same period last year, but the farmer received 5 per cent less cash.

The department report yester-day said the decline, a total of \$24,800,000,000, was caused by low-

\$24,800,000,000, was caused by lower prices.
However, it said the consumer paid more for goods in general, with prices of industrial goods rising slightly to balance the lower prices of farm goods. The report also noted a small boost in charges for transportation, rent, medical care and other services.
It said farm receipts from meat animals declined 7 per cent and for crops 2 per cent.


