SEATTLE (U—) Daniel and Rhoda Jane Spaulding, who only a few days ago were called Chun Nam and Yang Han Mo, parentless waifs in an orphanage in Korea, reached American soil Wednesday night.

They flew here from Seoul, via Tokyo, en route to the home of Mr. and Mrs. Cecil L. Spaulding in Berrien Springs, Mich. The Spauldings adopted Daniel, 2½, and Rhoda Jane, 1½, from a Seventh Day Adventist Orphanage in Seoul.

The round-faced, almond-eyed and happy little youngsters were picked up by the Adventists from the streets of war-torn Seoul, named and parentless. Now they have both, and their squeals of contentment filled the air at Immigration and Customs at Seattle-Tacoma International Airport while they waited for an eastbound plane.

They were brought to the states by Robert Pennabecker, Northwest Airlines official in Pusan, Korea, and his wife.

"They have tremendous appetites," Mrs. Pennabecker said. "They'll eat anything."
