Former Klamath Couple Now Living In Mexico

Letters from Mr. and Mrs. G. A. Shaddock, former longtime residents of Klamath Falls have been received here by Mrs. L. Dan Morgan and Mrs. Marion Barnes.

Shaddock is a retired Southern Pacific engineer and they are making their home in Mexico. Their address is:

Jalisco, Mexico.

Puerto Vallarta, according to one of Mrs. Shaddock's letters, is a very clean little fishing town on the west coast of Mexico, north

of Acapulco and south of Mazatlan.

"The streets are cobble stones," she wrote, "but the sidewalks and the esplanade are concrete. The street-cleaners wake me every morning sweeping the cobbles. Pigs roam the streets at night; I don't know where they go during the day—maybe into the houses. The town is clean and the people are friendly."

"Our house is on the street that fronts the beach and we have a lovely view. There are no window-panes or screens on the windows, but cedar shutters. There are few flies or bugs here."

There are no roads into Vallarta, so all travel in and out is made

either by boat or by air. Mail should be sent by air, she added.
