Local Children Benefit By Psychiatric Study

The Klamath County Child Guidance Advisory Council has made rapid strides in accomplishing its purpose during the past few months and work with children in the community in the field of psychiatry is moving smoothly under direction of Dr. Seth Kerron, Klamath County health officer of the Health Department for an appointment, Dr. Waterman said during his recent visit.

Oregon Medical School has given some psychiatric service to communities. Then a group of local citizens became interested in a more concentrated program here. The Klamath County Child Guidance Advisory Council resulted.

During the past few months, the following objectives have been accomplished: selection of 21 persons to serve on a community committee; the objectives of the community in securing psychiatric care has been defined; monthly services of a Psychiatrist and psychiatric case worker have been secured; some funds, approximately \$2,000 each from Klamath County and the state of Oregon have been secured; cooperation and support of the county court and public schools is assured; two classes in child guidance for teachers and clinic workers and interested
