The dog, who as Jamesy says was the best dog in the whole world, was killed by a Pacific Railroad train last month. Jamesy and Butchie had set out Jamesy's two older brothers and two older sisters to gather for nuts last Nov. 21. On the back, Butchie—a dachshund—was on the railroad tracks and struck by a train when his legs failed to carry him to safety.

Mossadegh Will Appeal Sentence

TEHRAN, Iran (P) — Ex-dictator Mohammed Mossadegh Tuesday appealed his conviction by a military tribunal on charges of treason and his sentence to three years in solitary confinement.

Authorities said it would take 20 days to set up an appeal court of seven judges to review the case of the fiery old ex-premier who was tried on charges of defying the orders of the Shah, attempting to overthrow the monarchy and dissolving the lower house of parliament illegally.

In the preliminary stages of Mossadegh's dramatic trial—sparked by the veteran politician's tirades, threats and capricious clowning—the defendant threatened to commit suicide if he were released and said he would not appeal if he were convicted.

But as in the case of every other threat he made during the 35-day trial, Mossadegh reversed himself. He wrote his request for an appeal on the document containing the court's sentence and signed it as required by law.

During the trial, the wealthy and emotional old nationalist also once threatened to go on a hunger strike but ended up by having three chickens for dinner.

Well on in his 70's, he challenged the public prosecutor, a man much his junior, to a wrestling match. He got up to walk out of the court several times, but nearly always collapsed after a few steps and allowed himself to be dragged back to his seat in a near-faint.

Iranians could expect similar table-pounding and dramatic tactics when Mossadegh's appeal hearing comes up. He had challenged the military court's competence to try him and had maintained he

still was premier, despite his ouster during a bloody, royalist coup last August which brought Premier Fazollah Zahedi to power.

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
