## African Chiefs Lay Up Trouble For French When They Start Airing Beefs

UNITED NATIONS, N. Y. (AP) — Native chiefs in Africa trouble the French almost as much as their changing chiefs of government at home.

U. N. Trusteeship Council petitions detailed Wednesday some of the difficulties the French have in their African Cameroons trust territory.

Because the Cameroonians are among the U. N.'s 20 million trusteeship wards, they can bring to the top international organization complaints that are handled in minor courts in many other countries.

Bob Dang Benoit was one complainant. He lives in Doune, in the Haut-Nyong region. Because he and his brothers were minors when their chiefs took over both the job and the Amagou house.

The latest alleged usurper, Kamanda, recently died and Bob Dang wants the job, as well as the house. Bob Dang says Kamanda stripped the house and he wants damages.

To the trusteeship council, now in recess until next spring, the French administering authority reported Bob Dang was not really in line of succession as chief. As to the house, the French answer indicated the Cameroonians are a thorough people. They said Kamanda vacated it, but "is said to have removed the roof slats, the rafters and the bricks of the veranda. . . . Since then the house has remained abandoned."

What looked like topsy turvy action was contained in a petition from Mbidia Joseph Assena, who claims that he ought to be "king"
