

# US, Russia Agree Over Atom-For-Peace Talks, But Timing Still Off

WASHINGTON (AP)—The United States and Russia were agreed today on starting preliminary atom-for-peace talks in Washington, but the important question of timing was still up in the air.

The Soviets announced the agreement last night in Moscow and the State Department quickly confirmed it.

Russia said its ambassador in Washington, Georgi M. Zarubin, would represent it at the talks to set a time, place and subject matter for full scale negotiations. No date was mentioned.

The State Department, within an hour, announced Secretary Dulles would "proceed at an early date to have the procedural conversations." That was another goad to the Soviets to get the talks going.

Time is short for Dulles, who is expected to leave two weeks from

today for Berlin and the Foreign Ministers Conference there Jan. 23 among the United States, Russia, Britain and France.

Dulles' has been pressing for early negotiations ever since President Eisenhower proposed, in his Dec. 8 address to the United Nations, that the world unite to strip the atom of "its military casing and adapt it to the arts of peace."

Under the Eisenhower plan, atomic materials and know-how would be pooled for peaceful purposes by the United States, Russia and other nations with a contribution to make. An international agency, under United Nations auspices, would control the pool. The hope is that such international effort might ultimately lead to control of atomic weapons also.

Dulles has said he planned to discuss the idea with Soviet Foreign Minister Molotov at the Berlin conference, originally proposed for Jan. 4. But when the meeting was postponed to Jan. 25, he instructed Charles E. Bohlen, U.S. Ambassador at Moscow, to take it up with Molotov.

Last night's Soviet communique, reporting talks yesterday and last Thursday between Bohlen and Molotov, said Bohlen sought preliminary atom conversations in Washington before Jan. 25 or at Berlin during the foreign ministers' get-together.

At yesterday's meeting, the communique said, Molotov told Bohlen Russia "considers it desirable" to get going and agreed to start in Washington.

There was no mention in the communique of the Soviet objection that Eisenhower's plan does not go far enough. The objection,

voiced Dec. 21 when Russia first agreed to negotiate the plan, was that it provided for peacetime atomic development but offered no restraints against atom bombs. Russia said the bomb should be outlawed, much as poison gas was,

under international pledges not to use it.
