

**Cattlemen
Draw Praise
From Benson**

COLORADO SPRINGS, Colo. (AP)—Secretary of Agriculture Benson today praised cattlemen for the adjustments they are making in beef production to provide a steady meat supply to win the market.

He said, producers of beef, pork, lamb, mutton, goat, sheep, and some other meats are not making such adjustments because of inducements to overproduce provided by rigid government price supports.

Benson said the cattle industry, which has reduced its production of beef, has reduced its production of other meats without piling up surplus government handouts.

In a speech prepared for a meeting of the American National Cattlemen's Assn., the secretary said that in beef cattle numbers have been brought about in the past year through increasing production of beef, and he commented that the 26 million head of cattle slaughtered in 1953 were quickly turned into consumers' tables, into storage, because this meat is not hanging over the head of the cattle industry.

The secretary said that through the high price supports for beefed crops—but not for cattle mountous surpluses—of the farm products have been at the same time, farm prices have continued the year-end downturn that began in the post-Korea peak in February 1951, he said.

Explaining that the cattle industry had operated without direct supports, Benson said the of stabilizing the cattle market now easier than would have thought possible a year or ago.

**Priest Raps

SHAWA, Ont. (AP)—A Roman Catholic priest who was expelled from Red China after 28 years' work said yesterday it is traveling through Communist countries than through the United States.

The Rev. Joseph Venini of Shaw was said in an interview he had more trouble crossing the United States on his way to Canada than he had crossing China.

The missionary said he was refused a U. S. visa because he came from a Communist country. He arrived here last Friday. He said after being held up in Cuba and Cuba for three days he was granted passage by the United States.

That means you came through a Communist country, he said. He added he was escorted by guards traveling by plane from Shaw to Detroit.

He said he was "practically a prisoner."

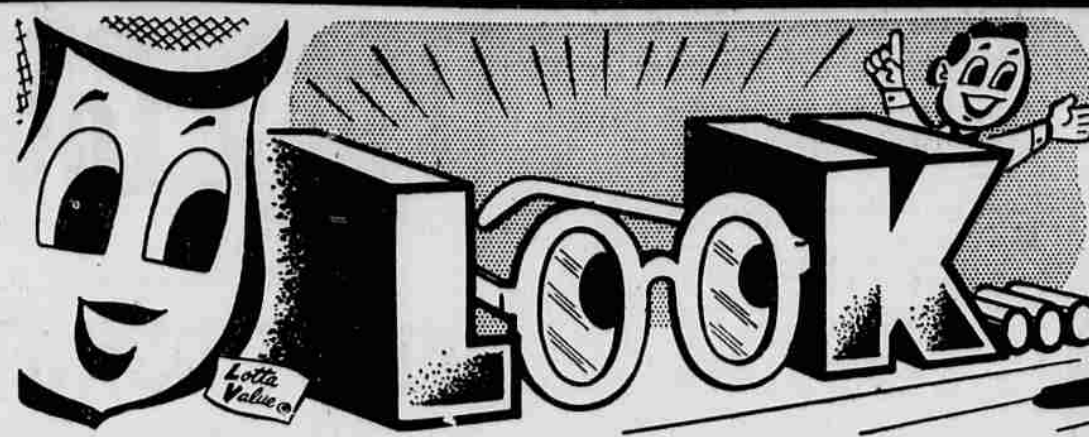
