Morse Raps Oregon Voters

WASHINGTON (AP) — Oregon is suffering an "Eisenhower recession" and retail sales in the state are dropping, Sen. Wayne Morse told the Senate Monday.

He said the administration's basic economic philosophy is a "duplication of the Hoover administration" and "the Republicans haven't learned a single economic fact of life since 1928 and 1929."

Morse, Oregon Independent, said these policies were leading to a full scale depression. Anyone who tries to attract attention to these economic conditions is accused by the administration of attempting to talk the nation into a depression, he said.

The administration's "hard money" policy was partly responsible for the recession, Morse declared.

He also criticized the power and public lands policies of Interior Secretary McKay and accused Atty. Gen. Brownell of not enforcing the anti-trust laws.

Knight In Favor Of Health Plan

SACRAMENTO, Calif. (AP) — Gov. Goodwin J. Knight advocates voluntary private health insurance plans written like \$50 or \$100 deductible auto collision policies.

If private insurance companies can't handle the load alone, he told his news conference yesterday, he favors setting up a non-competing state medical insurance fund which would offer policies on a strictly voluntary basis.

He said his idea was a better solution than President Eisenhower's proposal for a system of government re-insurance of private medical plans.

Traffic Officer On Nickel Spree

WICHITA FALLS, Tex. (AP) — Robert Walkup, 34, former city traffic department employee, was charged yesterday with embezzlement of more than \$8,000 in nickels from city parking meters in a 13-month period.

He told police he had spent the nickels on fishing trips, a state fair junket in Dallas, and two autos, among other things. He didn't have enough to make his \$5,000 bond.
