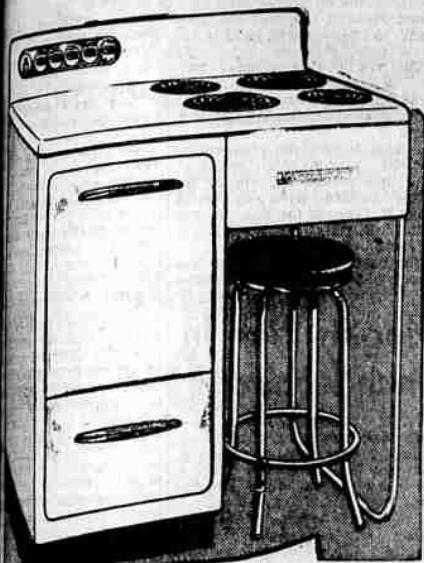


East Side APPLIANCES and OREGON FOOD STORE'S CAKE BAKING CONTEST
