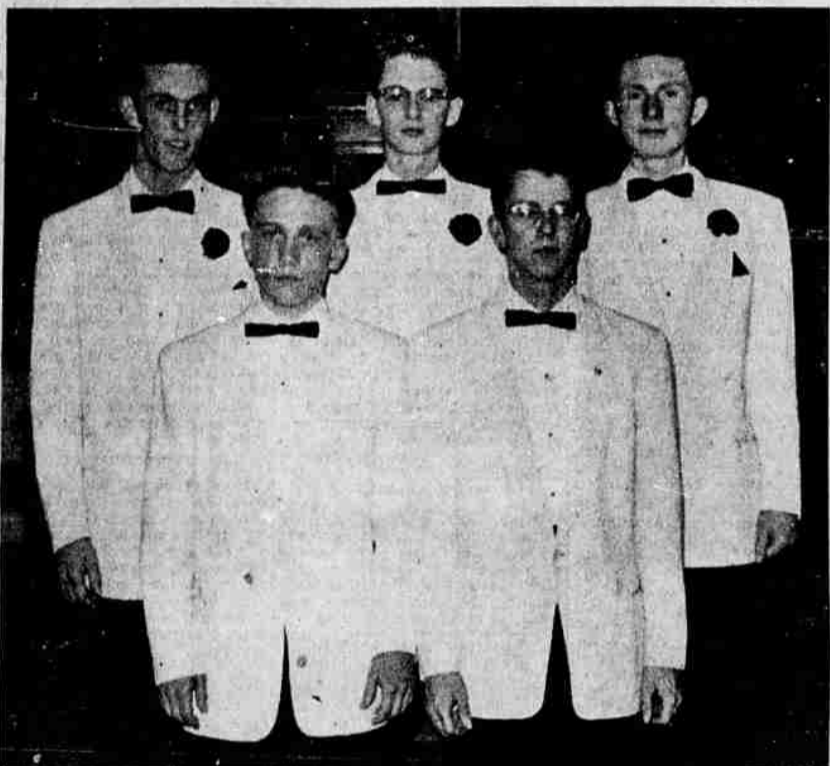

McCarthy Speech Fiays Democrats

CANTON, Ohio (AP)—Sen. Joseph R. McCarthy (R-Wis.) said the Democratic party has "irrevocably labeled itself" as standing for government by "Communists, crooks and cronies." In a speech last night before some 4,500 persons attending a Lincoln Day meeting, the Wisconsin senator said Democratic leaders had tried to "scare the country into a depression," so that they may win an election. The speech was the second of nine he is making on a tour of the nation. In a press conference after the address, McCarthy said "the greatest bulwark against the Communist menace is the church."
