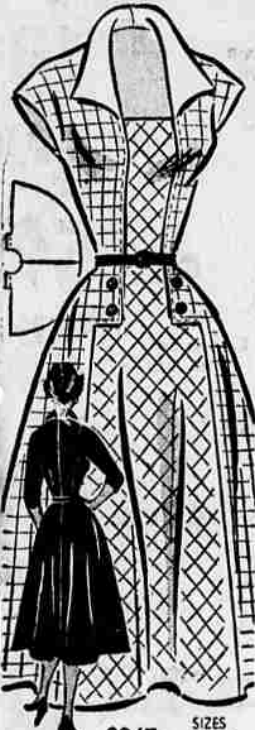

9267 SIZES 12-20

In a "new-dress" mood? Sew this in a jiffy! See how few seams—it's all straightaway stitching. Note the novel skirt panel that flares smartly as you walk. Note the crisp standup collar—pretty in white or a companion color to your dress.

NOODLE NESTS

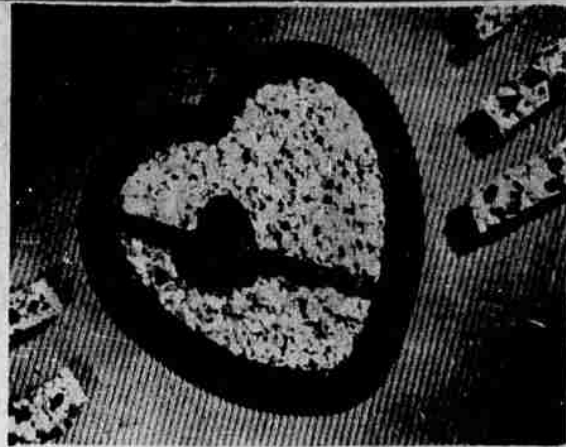
To make crisp nests of French fried noodles, allow one egg and 2 teaspoons of water for each four ounces of noodles. Beat the egg-water mixture until frothy and pour over noodles. Shape into nests on greased baking sheet and bake in a show oven (350 degrees) for about 20 minutes. These containers may be filled with creamed mixture.

EAT BREAKFAST

A good breakfast is a must all year long and particularly so during the cold winter. Hot cereal topped with a few cooked prunes makes an excellent dish. Keep a jar of cooked prunes in your refrigerator ready for use at a moment's notice.

ECONOMY BEEF

This term is applied to beef from cattle which come directly to market from the grassy plains and mountains of the West and have had no grain finishing. It is im-



portant to remember that lean beef usually needs slightly longer cooking time than beef containing a higher proportion of fat.

POP CORN is wonderful for a children's Valentine party or for family fun and enjoyment. In addition to bowls of hot buttered pop corn, try a pop corn heart centerpiece. Cook 1 cup sugar, ½ cup white corn syrup, ½ cup water, ¼ cup butter, ¾ teaspoon salt until sugar is dissolved. Continue cooking without stirring until syrup forms a brittle ball in cold water. Add ¾ teaspoon vanilla and stir only enough to mix. Place 3 quarts pop corn in large mixing bowl and pour cooked syrup slowly over it, mixing well. Wet hands slightly and transfer mixture to heart-shaped candy box and press down. If that is not available, cut a heart-shaped pattern from a piece of cardboard, place on top of pressed-out mixture and cut around it with a sharp, wet knife. Decorate with red ribbon and small heart and place on a large piece of red drawing paper as a background for your table centerpiece. Small hearts or bars can be made for favors. If the mixture becomes too stiff and brittle before you have finished, it can be softened quickly and easily by warming in the oven.
