Hill charged in a statement that a Democrat was announced last night by Sen. Douglas of Illinois. He said he will try to write \$52 million dollars more reductions into the excise tax bill now in the senate...

He said on the Meet Your Congress television program he proposes reductions on "necessities and nonluxuries." He said the cuts he advocates could mean a \$50 price reduction on automobiles and about \$25 on such appliances as refrigerators...

Douglas asserted that "the Republican program will not cure the deepening recession." He said the big tax revision bill now in the hands of the Senate Finance Committee "gives the average taxpayer a \$6 a year reduction in his tax load..."

Rep. Kean (R-NJ) on the same program said he knew of no one who had caused more jobs to be lost than had Douglas "through his preaching of gloom all the time" and Rep. Carl Curtis (R-Nebr) said the Illinois senator was spreading "fear psychology."
