

Farm Bureau Plans Meeting

Claude Conrad of Seattle, district manager for the Hell Company, will talk before a meeting sponsored by the Klamath County Farm Bureau to be held Monday, April 5, at 1:30 p.m., probably in the lecture room at the Klamath County Fairgrounds.

He will be accompanied by a factory engineer and they will discuss the manufacture of dehydrators for agricultural products, with special emphasis on the dehydration of alfalfa.

A 16 mm film will also be shown. According to Everett Metler, program chairman for the meeting, "The hay yield of the area might be increased by shortening the period between crops, with the possibility of a third cutting which could be dehydrated. This would insure a higher protein and mineral content of the third cutting," he added.

Earl Mack, president of the farm bureau, will preside.

Poultry Group Plans Meeting

"The broiler industry in Oregon has jumped from an annual production of 120,000 birds in 1934 to 5,200,000 in 1953," stated Conrad Brumester, president of the Oregon Poultry Council, in announcing plans for a meeting of members of Oregon's commercial broiler industry to be held in Portland at the Mallory Hotel, March 31.

The council's broiler committee, headed by Roy Martindale, will meet with processors, retailers and home economists at a 20th anniversary dinner to discuss plans for further development of the industry.

Martindale indicated that the industry is levying an assessment on its members for a fund to finance a development and educational program.

Berserk Man Wounds Cop

CHICAGO (AP) — A 35-year-old man, armed with a bayoneted rifle, shot a deputy sheriff in an unprovoked attack Tuesday night and then waged a wild, hour-long gun battle with dozens of state, county and suburban police before he was shot and captured.

Hundreds of shots were fired in the battle in a field in suburban Rich township, about 20 miles southwest of Chicago's Loop. More than 25 squads of police took part in the fight.

The gunman, Paul Pauling, was

wounded in the leg, hip and arm by eight bullets. His condition was reported serious in St. James Hospital in suburban Chicago Heights.

The deputy, Otto Svehla, 25, was shot in the chest. He was in the same hospital and was reported in fair condition.

County police said physicians told them Pauling had been drinking.

"I don't know why I did this," Pauling said. "I had no reason to do anything like this."

Police said Pauling was a driver for his brother, Elmer, who oper-

ates a bakery in suburban Lansing. The brother told police Pauling had received a medical discharge from the Army.

Svehla was shot soon after he and deputy Edward Rees were waved down by Pauling as he

stood in the middle of a rural road. The bayonet, a homemade blade fitted .22 caliber rifle into the car,
