Dynamite Blast Rocks Miami

MIAMI, Fla. (AP)—County officers began an intensive investigation today of a dynamite blast that shook houses and knocked out windows over a large region south of Miami. The blast at 1:30 a.m. yesterday was a mystery until four empty dynamite boxes were found by road patrolmen hidden in bushes a mile from the Florida Power and Light Co. plant at Cutler. Not far from where the boxes were discovered, the officers found a fresh hole 15 feet wide and four feet deep. The plant was not affected by the explosion, which was heard over an area of 30 miles.

Police Man Roadblock

ST. PAUL, Minn. (AP)—Roadblocks were set up in Minnesota and nearby Wisconsin today as highway patrolmen and sheriff's officers sought five prisoners who fled the Ramsey County Jail here after overpowering two jailers. Late yesterday police received a report that the car taken by the escapees had been seen a few miles north of here. However, search failed to locate it. Officers said the five men were considered dangerous. One of them, Muri Russell Jarvis, 29, Richmond, Ind., was to stand trial shortly on a charge of robbing the First National Bank of Cannon Falls, Minn., of \$101. He also was accused with a Bondurant, Iowa, bank robbery and a holdup of a grocery store in Hastings, Minn.

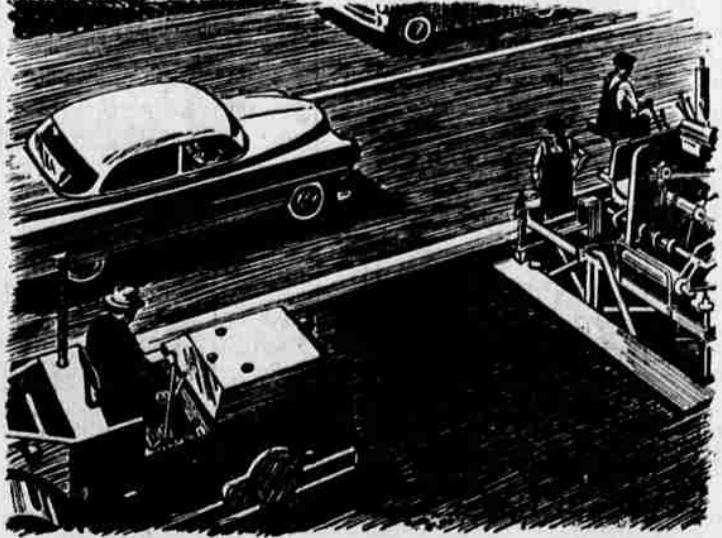
