BATAVIA, Ohio (AP)—Judge Harry Britton, ruling in an unemployment compensation case, says a pregnant woman is capable of holding down a job.

Mrs. Dolores S. Sheppard of Milford asked compensation after the Cincinnati & Southern Bell Telephone Co. moved its Milford office to Batavia.

The Bureau of Unemployment Compensation and its board of review said she was not entitled to the checks because she was physically unfit for employment.

Judge Britton said yesterday the board's decision was "unlawful, unreasonable and against the manifest of evidence." He ordered it to reconsider the case.
