

Guest Editorial On School Budget For Districts 1, 2

consideration are listed, with estimated costs. This preliminary work started in the Klamath Falls schools early in January.

Following the inspection of the school plants by the budget committee, a meeting is held in which budget proposals are weighed with respect to cost and urgency of need. This ordinarily results in some items being reduced, removed, or occasionally increased. At subsequent meetings the budget committee scrutinizes the various items still further until it seems, in their judgment, that the needs of the schools for the coming year have been adequately provided for. At that point the budget is officially approved and turned over to the board of directors by a notice published twice during a period of not less than 20 days immediately preceding the date of the election.

The voting qualifications are quite simple: registration as for regular elections in a precinct in the school district at least 30 days prior to the date of the election, and residence for at least six months in the school district in which the election is held.

An examination of the budgets of estimated expenditures, published today will reveal four columns: estimated expenditures for the coming fiscal year of 1954-1955; the budget allowance for the current fiscal year of 1953-1954; a small percentage to allow for the one quarter of taxes which are not due until after the close of the fiscal year; and also to help make up for the reduction of tax income because of discounts allowed for full payment in November. If the budget and the tax levy are approved at the special budget election, the board of directors then has the authority to levy the tax, which it does by properly informing the assessor, the county clerk, and the county superintendent of schools.

Members of the budget committee for School District No. 1 (elementary schools) this year were Lawrence Slater, Percy Murray, R. E. Hooker, W. M. Meade, and Ed Bell, appointed members; and E. B. Robinson, Mrs. Ralph Stearns, J. H. Schulze, T. J. O'Herra, and Mrs. L. A. Murphy, board members.

For Klamath Union High School District No. 2 the budget committee this year consisted of A. H. Bussman, E. D. Hickman, Fred Peterson, Kenneth E. Lambie, J. V. Owens, appointed members; and Scott Warren, Mrs. B. C. Johnston, Mrs. Calvin Peyton, L. Ernest Taylor, and J. P. Linman, board members.

For some years the boards of directors of School District No. 1 and Union High School District No. 2 have been meeting jointly, each board conducting its own business in turn, and then acting jointly in many policy matters. Probably one of the most important of these is the establishment of a single salary schedule for the teachers in both systems, as well as for other personnel. Following this precedent the budgets were of the two districts hold at least one joint meeting each year during budget-building time to consider salaries. Such a meeting was held this year, and in accordance with action taken at that meeting, no salary increases outside of those provided in established schedules were made. Salary items appear in the first five sections of the budgets, but the major one is quite naturally in the instructional section, since the largest percentage of personnel is represented there in the teaching staff.

A comparison between the proposed expenditures for 1954-1955 and those for 1953-1954 will reveal differences which will be discussed in the following paragraphs with respect to each district.

SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 1
General control: Little difference between the two years is indicated.
Instruction: An expanded program for the education of pupils whose educational progress might be seriously hindered by difficulties such as rheumatic fever, speech defects, polio, or other handicap will be noted.
A specialist in the handling of speech defects will be added to the staff. As explained in the general summary, increases in other salary items are those normally occurring in presently established schedules.

Operation of plant: Budgeting for fuel, light, and power is difficult because actual needs depend so much on weather conditions. A rate increase for electrical energy is recognized. Maintenance, repairs, and replacement: The committee believes it to be good business to protect an investment of over \$3,000,000 by keeping the buildings and equipment in good repair at all times.
This year, following an established practice, the budget com-

mittee visited each school plant. Needs always seem to be greater than the funds available, and so in many cases projects must be assigned a priority for future consideration. An illustration may be cited at Roosevelt School. For the past two or three years it has been evident that the retaining wall around the lower playground would need repair, but it has been delayed for other projects that seemed more urgent to the budget committee. This year it appeared that further delay might result in complete collapse of the wall, so an item of \$2350.00, based upon estimates obtained from qualified contractors, was included for the repair job.

Auxiliary agencies: There will be little change in the health and transportation items. The proposal for large cafeteria equipment includes a dishwashing machine, two double deck ovens, and one heavy electric mixer. For the past several years, one cafeteria each year has been equipped with a dishwashing machine.

Fixed charges: These remain somewhat the same from year to year. Fire insurance premiums may vary, as the regularly scheduled appraisals by a Portland firm may reveal increases in valuations. The year for the first time, schools came under the social security program. The retirement law became effective in 1946. It appears that the total cost of the combined retirement and social security program will be about the same as the old retirement law. Capital outlays: Expenditures in this field, of course, are those which add to the total value of the school plants. It will not be possible to go into detail, but some of the spots which will show substantial increases are listed below.

Fairview School: acoustic ceiling in the old auditorium and in the dining room, \$1775; Folding chairs, and chairs and desks for two rooms, \$3450; Mills School: black top a portion of playground, \$5000; Pelican School: central clock system, \$1400; fence grounds, \$2350.

Roosevelt School: acoustic ceiling of lower hall, new floor in girls' gym, and installation of cafeteria counter, \$5015; blacktop a portion of upper playground, and improve parking strip on Eldorado, \$3300.

As stated earlier, several of these items have been considered in previous years, and have been included this year under the "priority" plan.
Debt service: Heretofore, because of the fact that a budget becomes effective on July 1, some four and a half months before the taxes for that budget begin to come, it has sometimes been necessary for the district to borrow on short term notes for that period. However, due to the fact that dates of payments from the Basic School Support Fund have been changed, recognizing the problem of tax collection lag, and also that cash carry-overs have been substantial, the district has not been forced to borrow during the past year. Emergency fund: This fund was increased to absorb possible salary adjustments in the cost of living index, and also to absorb the costs of unforeseen emergency situations which might arise during the year.

UNION HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 2
General control: This item is almost the same as for last year.
Instruction: An apparent increase in teaching salaries is accounted for in the following provision of \$13,200 for three additional teachers in case the enrollment next fall makes extra teachers necessary. Present enrollment indicates that such may be the case.
Operation of plant: No change is indicated for next year.
Maintenance, repairs, and replacement: The total investment in buildings and equipment is slightly over \$1,600,000.00 and it has always been the feeling of the budget committee that this investment should be adequately protected by keeping it in good repair. An item of \$1560.00 was included to re-roof the grandstand. Another spot which shows an increase in teaching salaries is increase in the provision for replacement of typewriters, adding machines, calculators, and so on in the commercial department.

Auxiliary agencies: A slight decrease is shown.
Fixed charges: These estimates remain almost the same as those for last year.
Capital outlays: This section shows an appreciable decrease.
Debt service: During the past year it was unnecessary to borrow funds to tide the district over the period from July 1 to December 1. A small amount is budgeted in case the need should arise this year.
Emergency fund: No increase was made in the emergency fund for next year. It was the feeling of the committee that possible salary adjustments could be absorbed in the fund as presently established.
