

Spud Figure For Basin Explained

The Klamath Basin, and not the state of Oregon as reported Wednesday, will be permitted to ship 132 cars of potatoes on the government school lunch program, it was learned Wednesday following a meeting held at the offices of the Agricultural Stabilization and Conservation, in the Tower Theater building.

This allocation of 132 cars must start moving immediately as they are all for April delivery, stated Arnold Bodtker, administrative officer for the Oregon State ASC. Figures released by ASC county managers disclosed that 750 cars of potatoes had been offered by 123 growers in the basin. As the government will buy only 132 cars it was decided to accept one car each from the 123 growers and to divide the other 10 cars, plus future buying, if any, as follows: Klamath County 50 per cent; Modoc County 30 per cent and Siskiyou County 20 per cent.
