

Dairy Herd Test Reported

The March test report of the Klamath Dairy Herd Improvement Association shows that the 18 standard herds averaged 710 pounds of milk and 29.8 pounds of butterfat. The three owner-sampler herds averaged 1030 pounds of milk and 29.4 pounds of butterfat.

Topping the cows in the "70 Pounds Or Better Club" was Ely Ray, owned by Mario Rizzardo, Montague, with 2200 pounds of milk and 112 pounds of butterfat.

Henry Silva and Stan Masten and son each had one cow testing over 90 pounds of butterfat, while two cows, one owned by Mario Rizzardo, and the other by Ray Hobson, topped 80 pounds.

In the 70 to 80 pound group were cows from the herds of Ken Waters, Homer Baldwin, C. W. Ogle, Mario Rizzardo, Earl Tilton, Wilbur Reil-

ing, Masten and son, Bob Adams, Richard Peat and Ted Alberts.

Ballots received and counted at the county agent's office show the following members elected as directors: Ken Waters, Wilbur Reiling, Ray Hobson, E. G. Born and I. L. Harris. A meeting will be held in the near future and other officers elected.

Violinist To Be Heard

Tonight at 8:00 p.m. in Mills Auditorium Wayne Angel will be presented to the public in violin concert. A fine program of concert music has been prepared by the young violinist and his accompanist, Mrs. Rex (Aurora) Underwood, of the University of Portland. Wayne's repertoire will include "Concerto for Violin Op. 35, Allegro Moderato" by Tschalkowsky, "Introduction & Rondo Capriccioso" by Saint-Saens, "Three Preludes" by Gershwin, Heifetz, "Cortège" by Boulanger, and "Round of the Goblines" by Bazini.

Aurora Underwood will appear on the program as guest soloist. Mrs. Underwood is a pianist of exceptional ability and is well known to Klamath Falls audiences after her appearance here last year. Mrs. Underwood's piano numbers will include "Two Preludes" and "Fantaisie" Impromptu in C Minor by Chopin, "Mandolinata" by Saint-Saens, and "Gardens in the Rain" by Debussy.

Also to appear on the program is the Underwood Trio, which is composed of Aurora Underwood, pianist, and her son and daughter-in-law, Rex John Underwood, violinist, and Julianne Stone Underwood, cellist. This trio, well known on the Pacific Coast for its many fine appearances, is substituting for the Collegium, directed by Rex Underwood, unable to appear because of illness.

All funds obtained from the concert will go into his scholarship fund, and the check will be presented to Mr. Andrew Loney, Jr., custodian of the fund, by Mayor Paul Landry, immediately following the concert. The program offers the people of Klamath Falls the opportunity to hear a fine recital and at the same time avail themselves of the privilege of helping to promote the future success of a local artist.
