Swedish Dock Strike Ended

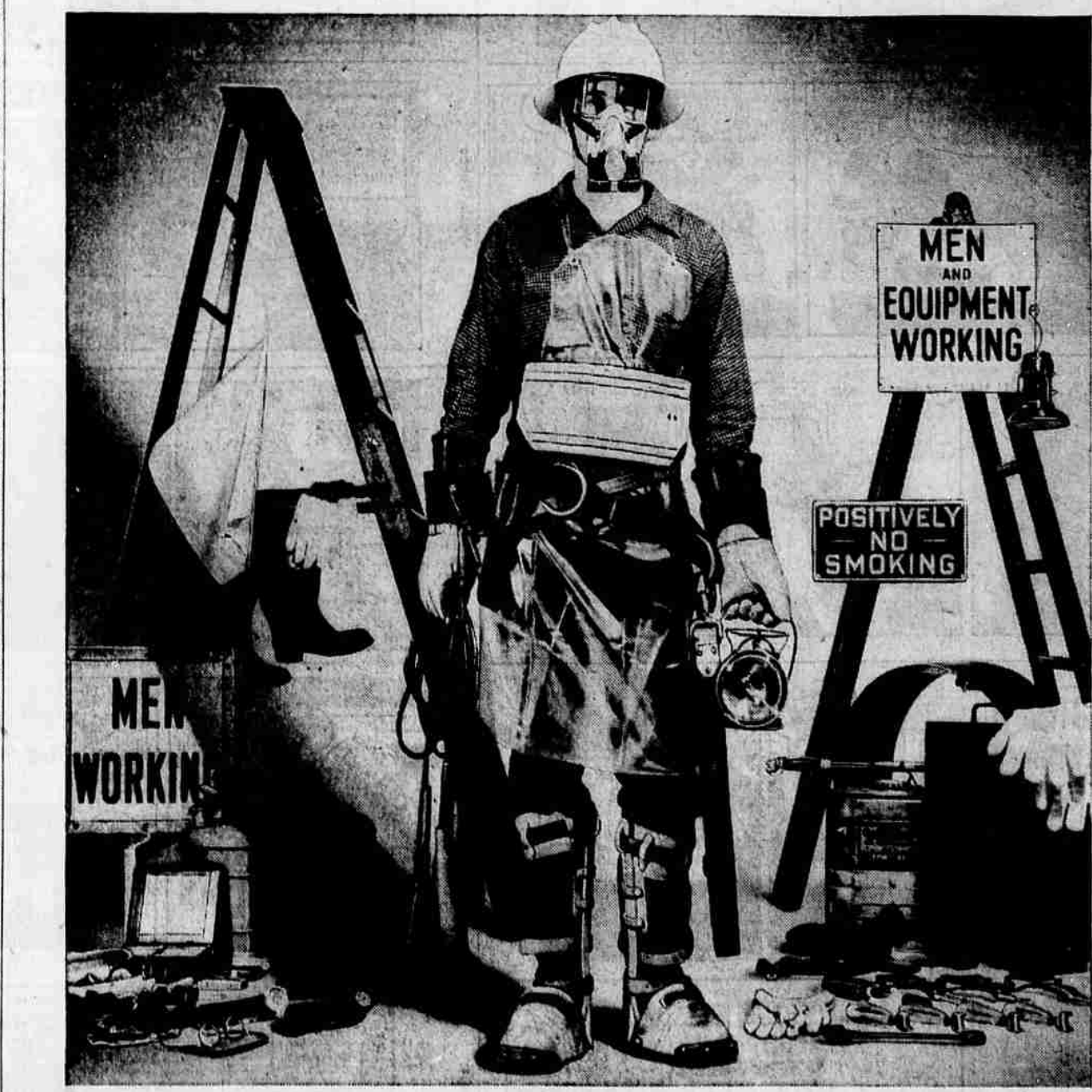
