

## Mentally Sick Help Reported

ST. LOUIS (AP)—The richest of all the mentally sick—schizophrenics—can be drawn back to reality over a bridge of words and action, a prominent psychiatrist reported today.

Dr. Frieda Fromm-Reichmann of Rockville, Md., told of new successes by psychiatric treatment that give more hope for saving hundreds of victims of this disease, once regarded as hopeless, insane and electric shock treatment sometimes work. This is another and useful way to save them, said Dr. Fromm-Reichmann of the Chestnut Lodge Sanatorium.

Schizophrenia, often called split personality, means escaping into an unreal world of the person's own making.

The same approach which helps other mental illnesses can be used to reach the schizophrenic, help him understand why he is sick, help him get well, Dr. Fromm-Reichmann told the American Psychiatric Assn.

She believes no matter how sick the schizophrenic seems to be, he still has some core of health, some contact with the real world. The psychiatrist can create a bridge of understanding with the patient and eventually help him get well. The psychiatrist becomes a part of the real world for which the sick mind can grope.

Dr. Fromm-Reichmann said schizophrenics are victims of pent-up hostility which they can't handle. They withdraw into themselves, and actually are afraid usually of taking out their anger against themselves or against other persons.

She believes they are not really withdrawn from contact with the world but simply have tried to cut off all communication with it. Even patients in an apparent state of stupor are frequently keenly observing what is going on and can remember it. But they give no signs of knowing.

What the psychiatrist says or does therefore can influence the patient and start building the bridge of communication.

## General Dean Gives Warning

PEORIA, Ill. (AP)—Maj. Gen. William F. Dean, who spent 38 months in a Communist prison of war camp in Korea, said last night he sees "complacency everywhere" in America.

He said "a great many people are becoming complacent" because the West has the atomic bomb and the H-bomb.

He told a dinner meeting of the Peoria Assn. of Commerce: "Complacency is the Communist's comrade."

Dean said the Communists still are counting "on our moral disintegration, disunity among ourselves, any factionalism, any racism and a capitalist depression every 10 years."

## Ike Asked To End Hearings

CONCORD, N. H. (AP)—Republican Gov. Hugh Gregg has called on President Eisenhower to end "the degenerating nature" of the McCarthy-Army hearings.

"The Republican party is losing prestige and honor due to the prolonged and ineffectual Senate hearings in which Sen. McCarthy and Army Secretary Stevens are playing the leading roles," Gregg said in a telegram to the President.

"Because we look to you as the leader of our party and as a Republican, I respectfully suggest a shift of emphasis by our leadership from the degenerating nature of these hearings to the more constructive issues on which the Republican party was elected to office."
