A certified check for Twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) on a solvent bank, payable to the Treasurer of the United States, must accompany each sealed bid. Persons bidding for or on behalf of companies, corporations, or partnerships must at the time of bidding submit in writing satisfactory evidence of their authority to do so. The deposits will be returned to the unsuccessful bidders. The deposit of the successful bidder will be applied as part of the purchase price against timber cut on this unit only or retained as liquidated damages if the bidder shall not execute the contract and furnish satisfactory bond for Fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) within sixty days from acceptance of his bid. If an oral bid is declared to be high at the close of the auction, the bidder must immediately confirm the bid by submitting it in writing on an Indian Service bid form. The right to waive technical defects and to reject any and all bids is reserved. The contract will specify that all designated timber shall be cut and removed from the unit prior to April 1, 1956. An advance payment will be required on each individual allotment contract as stipulated in the contract covering the entire unit. The advance payment must be made within thirty days of approval of the individual allotment contract.
