Miss Vallejos, a graduate of the Philippine University, came to this country in January, 1952 and enrolled at the University of Idaho, where she received her masters degree in home economics in June 1953. She then enrolled for two terms at Oregon State for advanced courses in her chosen field.

She taught home economics in public schools in her home country before coming here and plans to return to her profession.

gracious and very friendly, she said. She was invited to speak of the Philippines before many organizations both in Idaho and Oregon and was repeatedly entertained in private homes and at social events during her stay.

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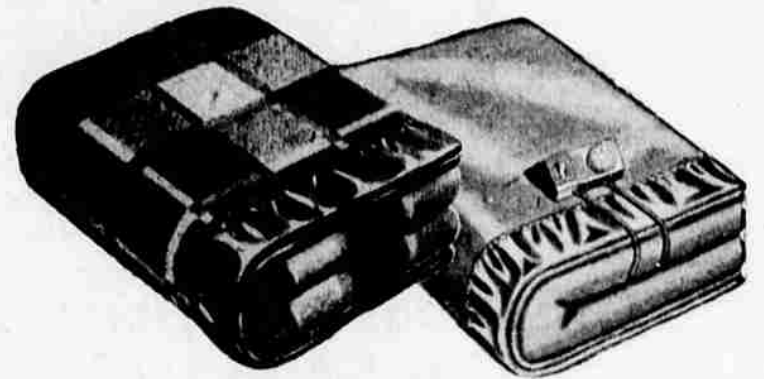


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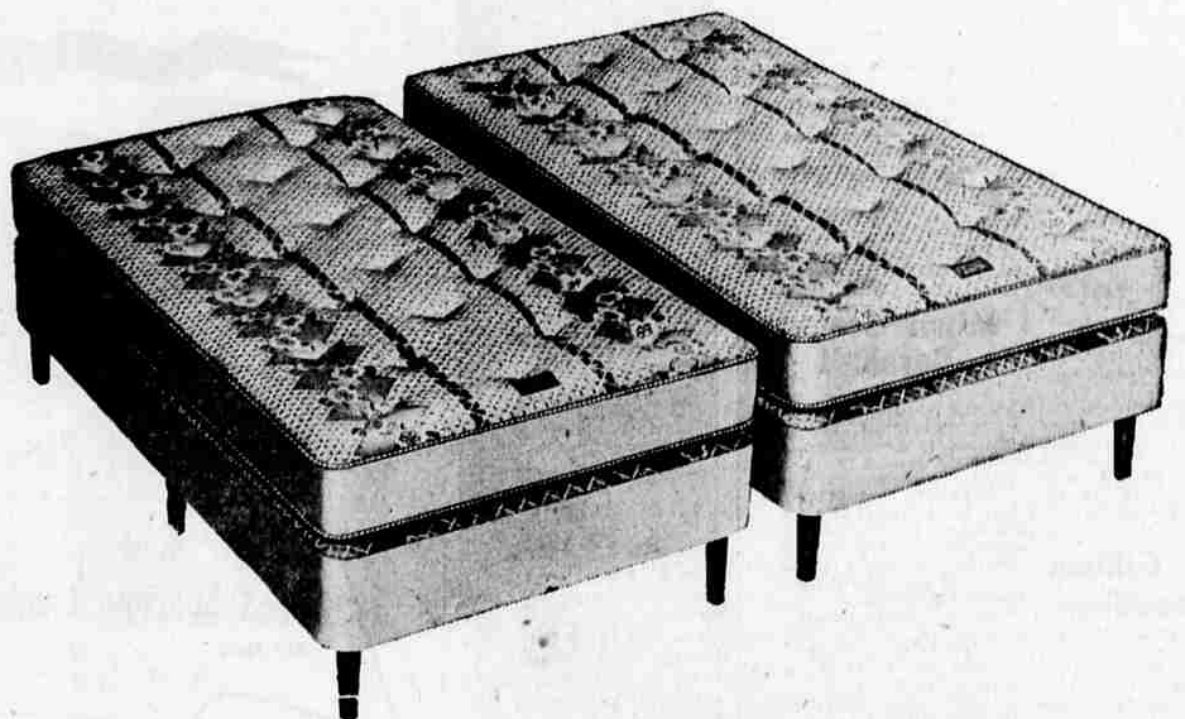
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
