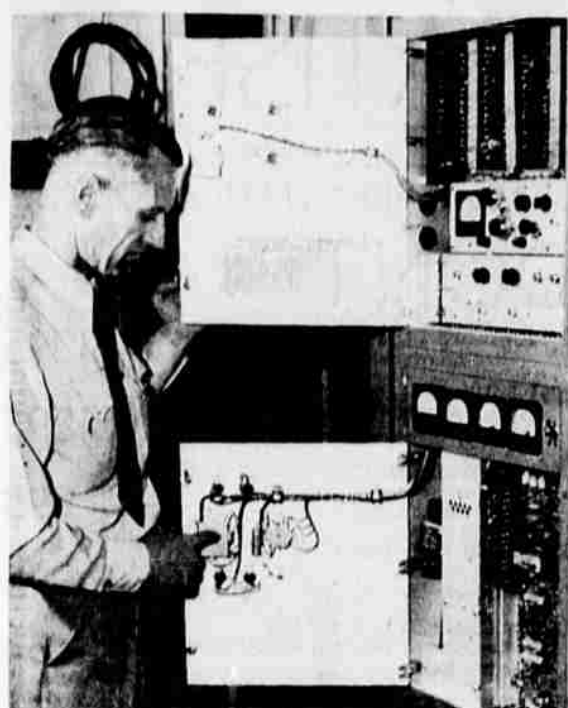

Sealed bids, in duplicate, on forms provided therefore, marked outside "Bid, Fred Johnson Allotment" and addressed to the "Superintendent, Klamath Indian Agency, Klamath Agency, Oregon," will be received until 2:00 o'clock, p.m., Pacific Standard Time, on May 21, 1954, for the purchase of all merchantable timber estimated to be 216,000 feet B.M. Lodgepole Pine, more or less, which estimates are not guaranteed, on a tract within the Klamath Indian Reservation, described as the SW 1/4, Section 36, Township 34 South, Range 8 East, W.M. Each bid must state the price per thousand feet B.M. Scriber Decimal C Log Scale that will be paid for the timber cut. No bid will be considered for less than \$12.00 per thousand feet B.M. for ponderosa pine and \$3.00 per thousand feet B.M. for Lodgepole Pine. A certified check on a solvent bank made payable to the Special Disbursing Agent in the amount of twenty per cent of the estimated value of the timber at the bid price must accompany each bid. The deposit will be returned to unsuccessful bidders. The deposit of the successful bidder will be held in lieu of bond pending satisfactory completion of the terms of the contract or retained as liquidated damages if the bidder shall not execute the contract within 30 days from acceptance of his bid.
